### I. Introduction.

- A. On one hand, there are the apostles... (Mk 10.28)
- B. And on the other hand, there are Jesus' enemies... (Jn 8.48; cf. Ps 56.5-6; 41.5-6)
- C. But in between these two extremes...

### II. The \_\_\_\_\_ multitude. (Jn 6.14,15,24-26,60,66)

- A. After the miracle, Jesus was their greatest hero.
- B. But after He teaches them something difficult, they forsook Him.

### III. The \_\_\_\_\_ - \_\_\_\_\_ believers.

- A. Examples... (Lk 18.18-23; Jn 9.18-23; 12.42-43)
- B. But Jesus said... (Mt 10.32-33; 13.44-46; cf. Heb 13.13)

### IV. The \_\_\_\_\_ disciples.

- A. Not quite willing to take a stand... (Jn 19.38-40)
- B. Waiting for "just the right moment"... (Mk 15.43)

### V. The Lord's \_\_\_\_\_ people. (Jn 11.17-32)

- A. Conspiring against them - *proximity to Jerusalem, their Jewish friends, and their wealth...*
- B. Yet these are people of sure faith! (cf. 2Tim 2.19)
