

## **#11 - The Broken Covenant (Jeremiah 11)**

### **I. The Words of This Covenant (11:1-8)**

- Remember that early in Jeremiah's ministry \_\_\_\_\_ had found " \_\_\_\_\_ " (2 Kings 22:8-13)
- Deuteronomy 28:15 – "if you do not \_\_\_\_\_ ... all these \_\_\_\_\_ will come upon you and overtake you."
- Jeremiah is \_\_\_\_\_ the \_\_\_\_\_ that Israel made with Jehovah at Mt. Sinai.
- Inseparable connection between the \_\_\_\_\_ , \_\_\_\_\_ , and \_\_\_\_\_ . (see Matthew 7:15-27)

### **II. Conspiracy in Judah (11:9-17)**

- The " \_\_\_\_\_ " is that all of Judah has joined together in \_\_\_\_\_ against their God. (9)

### **III. A Prophet is Not Without Honor, Except... (11:18-23)**

- Jeremiah laments being a \_\_\_\_\_ led to \_\_\_\_\_ –they were plotting his life and he didn't know it. (18-19)
- He calls out for God to take \_\_\_\_\_ on his enemies. (20)
- These men were from Anathoth—Jeremiah's \_\_\_\_\_. (21, see 1:1)
- They threatened to \_\_\_\_\_ Jeremiah if he would not stop \_\_\_\_\_ in God's name. (21)
