Genesis 6-9

Noah trusted in God's power & authority

- To judge the world - Gen. 6:5-7,11,18
 - To flood, destroy the world - Gen. 6:13,17
 - To prepare a way Gen. 6:13-22
 - To deliver - Gen. 6:8, 18-19; 7:23
 - To provide - Gen. 7, 6:21, 23; 8:1
 - To restore - Gen. 8:1, 13, 15-17

Do you trust in God's power and authority?

- Gen. 1:1, Rev. 22:13 God is creator - alpha and omega
- Ex. 20:3-17; Matt. 17:5; 28:18-20 lawgiver, authorizer
- Jn 19:11, Rom. 13:1; Ps. 75:7 - to authorize authority
- Acts 2:24, Eph. 1:20 raised Christ from the dead
- Eph. 2:1, 5 raise us spiritually & 1 Cor. 15:51-52 physically
- James 4:12 God is our judge with power to save & destroy
- John 12:48 God's word judges mankind
- Acts 17:31; Matt 25:31-46 Jesus appointed to judge in end
- **Gen. 7:17-23** God destroyed the Earth by flood

Trust in God's authority & power put to work

- Covenant with Noah Gen. 6:8, 18 because Gen. 6:9
- Instruction for deliverance Gen. 6:14-22; 7:5, 16; 8:15
- God communicates through specific & general commands
 - LS: Matt. 26:26-28, 1 Cor. 11:23-34, Acts 20:7
- Expedients are not additions: 2 Sam.6; Ex. 37; Deut.10:8
- Eph. 5:19; Col. 3:16 sing psalms, hymns, spiritual songs
- Acts 2:38, Rom. 6:3-4 baptism (immersion) for the remission of sins
- Mt. 28:19, 20 Go, make disciples, baptizing, teaching

Noah trusted in God's grace and promises

- Noah found grace in the eyes of the Lord Gen. 6:8
- God's promise of judgement Gen. 6:5-7,11-13
- God's promise to destroy by flood Gen. 6:17
- God's promissory covenants Gen. 6:18,19; 8:17, 21; 9:8-17
 - Including plan for salvation by ark through water
 - God warned, God extended grace, God prepared a plan, and Noah obeyed (1 Pet. 3:20)




Do you trust in God's grace and promises?

- 2 Pet. 3:9 God is not slack concerning his promises
- 2 Pet. 3:1-12; [Matt 24:36-39](#) destroy, judge the world again
- Jn. 3:16, Matt. 11:28-30 Grace extended and offered to all
- Acts 20:24 gospel of grace of God
- 2 Thess. 2:14-15 called by gospel, must live by the word
- The call can only be answered with obedience - Mark 16:16, Rom. 6:1-6,16-17; Acts 2:37-38; Acts 22:16
- Rom. 6:22 promise of eternal life for the saved
- [1 Peter 3:20-21](#) Noah and flood served as model

Trust in God's grace & promises put to work

- Covenant with Noah [Gen. 6:8, 18](#) because [Gen. 6:9](#)
- God's grace did not build the ark
- God's grace always coupled with obedience [Gen. 6:22, 7:5, 16](#); [Heb. 11:1, 6](#); [Eph. 2:5-10](#) by grace through faith we are made alive, made Christ's [workmanship](#)
- By grace, God offered to spare Noah; offered life
 - So by faith, Noah - [Heb. 11:7](#)
- Noah, a preacher of righteousness - [2 Pet. 2:5](#)
- Noah's offering (1/7th of all animals, birds) - [Gen. 8:20](#)

Trust that faith works and is rewarded

- Gen. 6:8 Noah found grace in the eyes of the Lord
 - Gen. 6:13-17 God extended a means for deliverance
 - Gen. 6:22; 7:1, 5, 16 Noah was obedient and was accepted into the ark
 - Gen. 7:7, 13, 23 wife, sons, and son's wives saved
 - Noah was successful as husband, father
 - Gen. 8:1, 15 God remembered Noah and his family
 - Hebrews 11:6; Romans 10:17; James 2:18
