- 1. By Agreeing to Sin Together (Prov 1:10-15; Ac 5:2, 7-9)**
- 2. By Repeating the same Sin at different times (1 Ki 15:33-34)**
- 3. By Arranging for the Sin to be Committed (2 Sam 12:9)**
- 4. By Consenting to / Approving of the Sin (Ac 8:1; Rom 1:32)**
- 5. By Refusing to Rebuke / Censure the Sin (Ezek 3:17-21)**
