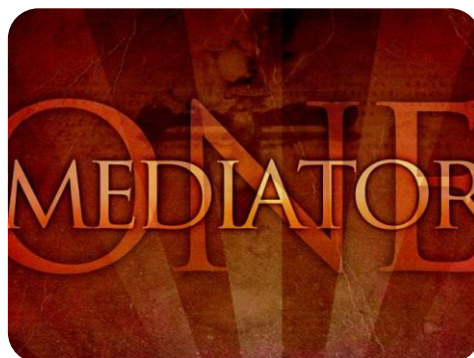

### THE NEED FOR A MEDIATOR

### WHAT IS A MEDIATOR

“One who helps negotiate between two feuding parties. From the Latin word ‘medius,’ which means middle. A mediator is to remain in the neutral middle rather than taking one side over another, in order to help both sides resolve a dispute.” (Vocabulary.com)

➤ Old Testament: yakach (yaw-kahh') - to be right, correct; reciprocal, to argue; to decide, justify or convict, maintain, plead, reason together...” (Strongs 03198).

➤ New Testament: mesites (mes-ee'-tace) a go-between, an internunciator, one who shows or describes someone or something clearly and completely; a reconciler, intercessor (Strongs 3316).

Therefore, a mediator is one who facilitates reconciliation between parties separated by some matter of difference.

### WHAT CONDITIONS MANDATE MEDIATION?

- A \_\_\_\_\_ arises between two or more parties
- An \_\_\_\_\_ stands in the way of reconciling their differences
- The \_\_\_\_\_ between the parties is viewed by one or both parties as unequal
- The \_\_\_\_\_ of one or both parties prevents their coming together

### WHAT CHARACTERISTICS QUALIFY ONE TO BE A MEDIATOR?

1. He must be a friend to both parties, trusted by both to be objective and concerned for the best interests of both
2. He must be completely honest and open in his representation of both parties' issues and needs
3. And, he must be willing to work diligently and sacrificially to bring about a peaceful resolution to the matter.
