- Psalm 78 (p 672)
Contemplation of Asaph
- Numbers 23 (p 181)
Balaam's oracles (also chapter 24)
- 1 Kings 4:32-34 (p 390)
Same word used for Solomon
- Proverbs 1 (p 725)
Proverbs and parables are similar

Two Distinctions

- When Jesus used parables He used real stories for application

Sowers sowing seed; shepherds losing sheep; people losing coins; prodigal sons

- Two stories that are not parables:

Judges 9 (p 287) Probably a FABLE

Luke 16:19-31 (p 1205) A rich man and the man LAZARUS!

2 Samuel 12:1-6 (p 362)

Ezekiel 19 (p 974)

PARABLES IN THE OLD TESTAMENT

Parable of lioness and parable of vine
Lamentation over Israel's fallen royalty
The destruction of the kingdom; wasted

Book of Hosea (p 1038)

PARABLES IN THE OLD TESTAMENT

Hosea marries Gomer; she is unfaithful

The story of God's love for Israel

She is unfaithful; God redeems her

Amos 7 (p 1062)

PARABLES IN THE OLD TESTAMENT

Locust / Fire / A Plumb Line

***Doom is fixed for Israel; Wrath of God
against Israel; Measure of God's justice***

Amos 8 (p 1063)

The summer fruit

***Late fruit, fully ripe; a symbol of a people
ripe for judgment***
