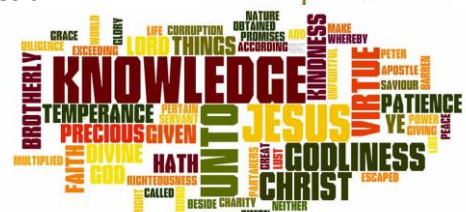
**Love** That which finds its origin, and is based on the worthiness or preciousness of the person loved.
