## THE GREAT RESTORATION

*I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service. And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God. (Romans 12:1-2)*

### Romans 12:1-2 (p 1305)

*For I say, through the grace given to me, to everyone who is among you, not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think, but to think soberly, as God has dealt to each one a measure of faith. (v3-8)*

- (9) Let love be without \_\_\_\_\_. Abhor what is evil. Cling to what is \_\_\_\_\_.
- (10) Be kindly affectionate to one another with brotherly love, in honor giving preference to one another;
- (11) not lagging in diligence, \_\_\_\_\_ in spirit, serving the Lord;
- (12) rejoicing in hope, patient in tribulation, continuing steadfastly in \_\_\_\_\_;
- (13) distributing to the needs of the saints, given to hospitality.
- (14) Bless those who persecute you; bless and do not curse.
- (15) Rejoice with those who \_\_\_\_\_, and weep with those who \_\_\_\_\_.
- (16) Be of the same mind toward one another. Do not set your mind on high things, but associate with the humble. Do not be wise in your own opinion.
- (17) Repay no one evil for \_\_\_\_\_. Have regard for good things in the sight of all men.
- (18) If it is possible, as much as depends on you, live peaceably with all men.
- (19) Beloved, do not \_\_\_\_\_ yourselves, but rather give place to wrath; for it is written, "Vengeance is mine, I will repay," says the Lord.
- (20) Therefore "If your enemy is hungry, \_\_\_\_\_ him; if he is thirsty, give him a \_\_\_\_\_; for in so doing you will heap coals of fire on his head."
- (21) Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good.
