## A SLAVE

*So likewise you, when you have done all those things which you are commanded, say, 'We are unprofitable servants. We have done what was our duty to do.'* (Luke 17:10)

Grammar check ..... Delivery: sensitivity. A slave should be "an enslaved person." Slave may be considered dehumanizing toward people subjected to slavery. Consider changing the word or phrase.

<i>1 Corinthians 9:19</i>	I have made myself a <b>servant</b> to all, that I might win the more.
<i>Colossians 1:7</i>	As you also learned from Epaphras, our dear fellow <b>servant</b> .
<i>Colossians 4:7</i>	Tychicus, a beloved brother, faithful <b>minister</b> , and fellow <b>servant</b> in the Lord.
<i>Colossians 4:12</i>	Epaphras, who is one of you, a <b>bondservant</b> of Christ.
<i>James 1:1</i>	James, a <b>bondservant</b> of God and of the Lord Jesus Christ.
<i>2 Peter 1:1</i>	Simon Peter, a <b>bondservant</b> and apostle of Jesus Christ.
<i>Jude 1</i>	Jude, a <b>bondservant</b> of Jesus Christ,
<i>Revelation 1:1</i>	John calls himself a <b>servant</b> .

### The Chinese Language

The “mouth man” or “spokes person” for the family was usually the oldest son or brother

Well known history and common everyday things were used to make a word so people could remember it

### Long before Buddha, the Chinese people worshipped the same God described in the Bible.

The Proof is in the Ancient Chinese \_\_\_\_\_

Many in China Today believe that the Bible is a Western book

- ✓ They believe it is simply \_\_\_\_\_ and fable written by western men; they think of it as an English book
- ✓ The Bible was not written in English but in \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_
- ✓ It's first writers were from Egypt & Babylon (Iraq)
- ✓ The first five books were written by \_\_\_\_\_, an adopted son of the king of Egypt (1400 B.C.)
- ✓ These five books focus on the beginning of the nation of Israel; but the first 11 chapters of the Bible records the history that all nations have in common
