## WHO IS PILATE?

*I urge you in the sight of God who gives life to all things, and before Christ Jesus who witnessed the good confession before Pontius Pilate., (1 Timothy 6:13)*

Paul refers to Pilate *2 Timothy 6:13-16 (p 1365)*

Pontius Pilate ~ Jesus The blessed and only Potentate, the King of kings and Lord of lords (v15)

Peter's sermon at \_\_\_\_\_ *Acts 3:13 (p 1255)*

Rejoicing saints *Acts 4:23-31 (p 1257)*

Paul's sermon at \_\_\_\_\_ *Acts 13:26-31 (p 1270)*

All of these passages would have been referenced during the time of Pilate *Luke 3:1 (p 1181)*

- ✓ Tiberius Caesar (succeeded Augustus 14 AD)
- ✓ Pontius \_\_\_\_\_ (5<sup>th</sup> governor in Judea)
- ✓ Herod Antipas (son of Herod the Great)
- ✓ Philip tetrarch of Iturea
- ✓ Lysanias tetrarch of Abilene



Nothing is known of his early life

- ✓ Educated, \_\_\_\_\_, well-connected
- ✓ Equestrian order (middle rank of Roman nobility)
- ✓ Probably a Roman \_\_\_\_\_
- ✓ Governor: Military and Judicial
- ✓ Had \_\_\_\_\_ to appoint the Jewish High Priest



### TROUBLE IN PALESTINE

Moved his headquarters from Caesarea to Jerusalem; soldiers brought in military standards with Emperor's image

Taking the \_\_\_\_\_ (sacrificial offerings) to build an aqueduct to Jerusalem. *Mark 7:11 (p 1160)*

Massacred some Galileans during a feast *Luke 13:1-4 (p 1201)*

Barabbas part of a \_\_\_\_\_; murder; robbery *Luke 23:18-19 (p 1216)*

**Jesus and Pilate** *Matthew 27:1-2 (p 1147); Mark 15:1-5 (p 1174); Luke 23:1-5 (p 1216); John 18:28-40 (p 1247)*

Pilate sends Jesus to \_\_\_\_\_ *Luke 23:6-12 (p 1216)*

Pilate's wife warns him *Matthew 27:19 (p 1148)*

**Pilate knew Jesus was innocent** Tries to \_\_\_\_\_ Him *Matthew 27:21-26 (p 1148)*

Gratifies the crowd *Mark 15:15 (p 1174)*

Finds no \_\_\_\_\_ *Luke 23:13-25 (p 1216)*

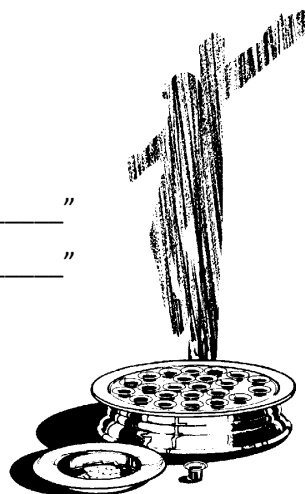
### THE PASSOVER
