- NEGATIVE: I am not smart; I am not good-looking; I am not rich

Luke 12:15 (p 1199) = WRONG VALUES

Jesus knew who He was (v 3)

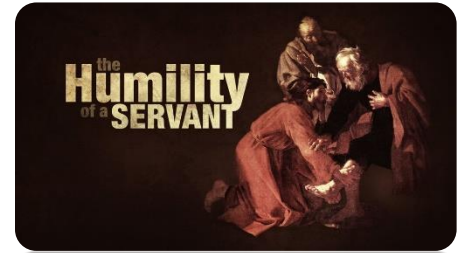
He was \_\_\_\_\_ *John 1:1-3 (p 1220)*
