THE CRUCIFIXION OF JESUS

And when they had mocked Him, they took the robe off Him, put His own clothes on Him, and led Him away to be crucified. Now as they came out, they found a man of Cyrene, Simon by name. Him they compelled to bear His cross. And when they had come to a place called Golgotha, that is to say, Place of a Skull, they gave Him sour wine mingled with gall to drink. 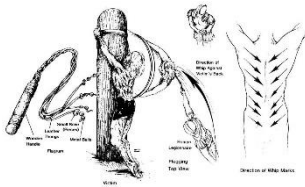
DEATH OF JESUS NOT A MISTAKE: Matthew 16:21 (p 1131)

Mock Him - Spit on Him - Shamefully treat Him - Scourge Him - Crucify Him - Kill Him

JESUS IN THE GARDEN: Luke 22:44 (p 1215)

- ✓ SCOURGING Then Pilate therefore took Jesus and scourged him. John 19:1 (p 1247)
- ✓ BEARING A CROSS And he bearing his cross went forth into a place called the place of a skull, which is called in the Hebrew Golgotha: John 19:17 (p 1248)
- ✓ CRUCIFIXION Where they crucified him, and two other with him, on either side one, and Jesus in the midst. John 19:18 (p 1248)
- ✓ DEATH When Jesus had received the vinegar, he said, "It is finished"; and he bowed his head and gave up his spirit. John 19:30 (p 1248)
- ✓ BLOOD & WATER But one of the soldiers with a spear pierced his side, and forthwith came there out blood and water. John 19:34 (p 1249)
