Withstanding The Pressure of Being A Christian

I. Pressure From Being A Christian

Matthew 7:13-14 "Enter by the narrow gate; for wide is the gate and broad is the way that leads to destruction, and there are many who go in by it. 14 Because narrow is the gate and difficult is the way which leads to life, and there are few who find it.

Matthew 5:10-11 <u>Blessed are those who are persecuted for righteousness' sake</u>, For theirs is the kingdom of heaven. 11 "Blessed are you when they revile and persecute you, and say all kinds of evil against you falsely for My sake.

John 12:42-43 Nevertheless even among the rulers many believed in Him, but because of the Pharisees they did not confess Him, lest they should be put out of the synagogue; 43 for they loved the praise of men more than the praise of God.

1 Peter 4:3-4 For we have spent enough of our past lifetime in doing the will of the Gentiles — when we walked in lewdness, lusts, drunkenness, revelries, drinking parties, and abominable idolatries. 4 In regard to these, they think it strange that you do not run with them in the same flood of dissipation, speaking evil of you.

II. Pressure From Those Walking In Lewdness And Lust

2 Corinthians 6:17 Therefore "Come out from among them And be separate, says the Lord. Do not touch what is unclean, And I will receive you."

1 Peter 2:11 Beloved, I beg you as sojourners and pilgrims, <u>abstain from fleshly lusts which war</u> against the soul,

Ephesians 5:11-12 And <u>have no fellowship with the unfruitful works of darkness</u>, but rather expose them. 12 For it is shameful even to speak of those things which are done by them in secret.

Psalm101:3 <u>I will set nothing wicked before my eyes</u>; I hate the work of those who fall away; It shall not cling to me.

III. Pressure From Those Walking In Drinking Parties

Proverbs 20:1 Wine is a mocker, Strong drink is a brawler, And whoever is led astray by it is not wise.

Proverbs 23:29-30 Who has woe? Who has sorrow? Who has contentions? Who has complaints? Who has wounds without cause? Who has redness of eyes? 30 Those who linger long at the wine, Those who go in search of mixed wine.

Habakkuk 2:15 "Woe to him who gives drink to his neighbor, Pressing him to your bottle, <u>Even to</u> make him drunk, That you may look on his nakedness!

IV. Pressure From Those Following False Teaching

2 Peter 2:1-2 But there were also false prophets among the people, even as <u>there will be false teachers</u> among you, who will secretly bring in <u>destructive heresies</u>, even denying the Lord who bought them, and bring on themselves swift destruction. 2 <u>And many will follow their destructive ways, because of whom the way of truth will be blasphemed.</u>

Ephesians 4:4-6 There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called in one hope of your calling; 5 one Lord, one faith, one baptism;

Luke 6:26 Woe to you when all men speak well of you, For so did their fathers to the false prophets.
