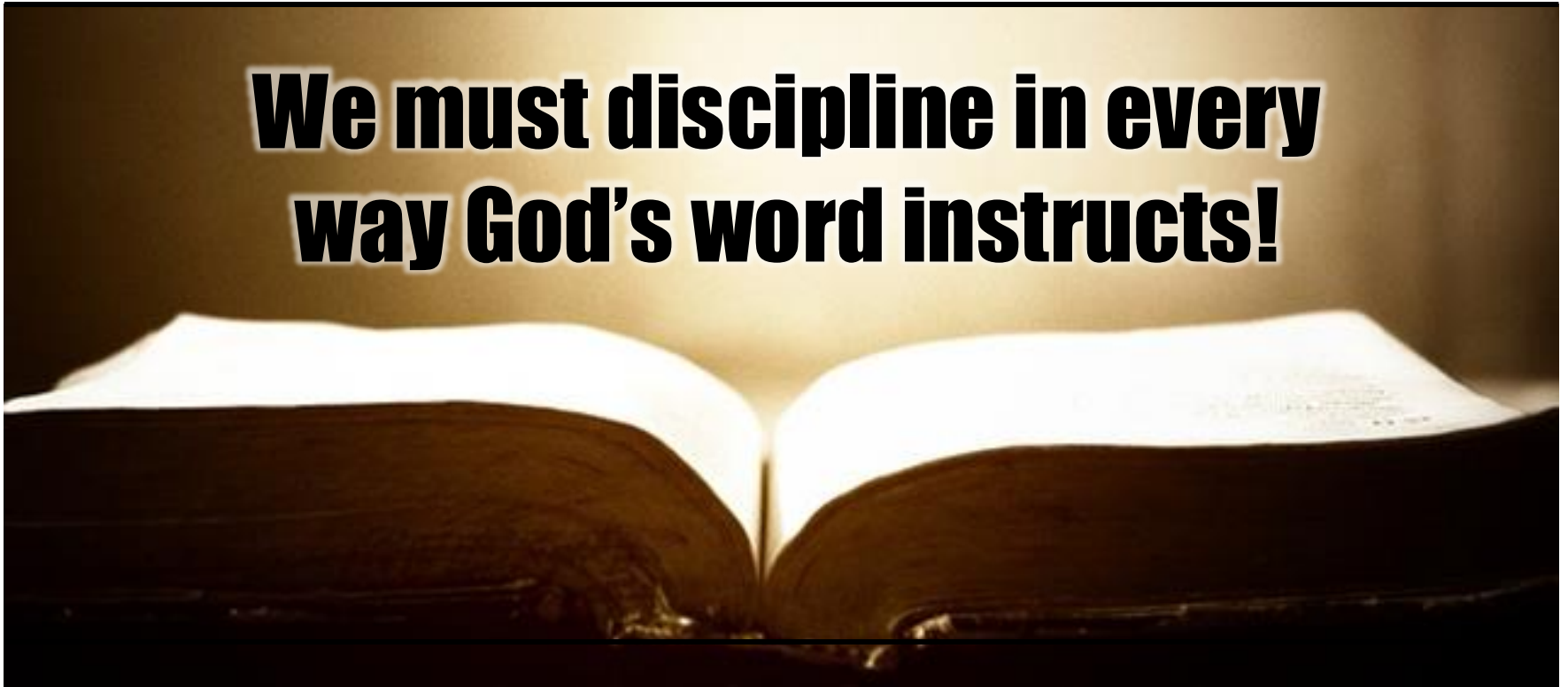

- **Instructive**
(Prov. 4:1-6; Eph. 6:4)
- **Cautionary**
(Col. 3:16; 1Thes. 5:14)
- **Corrective**
(2 Tim. 2:25; Ti. 2:12)
- **Punitive**
(1 Cor. 5:2; 2 Thes. 3)

2Tim. 3:16 All Scripture is inspired by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, for training in righteousness; **17** so that the man of God may be adequate, equipped for every good work. **4:1**

I solemnly charge you in the presence of God and of Christ Jesus, who is to judge the living and the dead, and by His appearing and His kingdom: **2** preach the word; be ready in season and out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort, with great patience and instruction.
