## Consider Jesus...

- ✓ Everyone understands that Jesus and the Father are separate persons (John 5:19-23).
- ✓ Everyone understands Christ was still ONE with Him (John 10:30).
- ✓ It is the same with the Holy Spirit (1 Peter 1:2).
