Overland church of Christ Week6 2021 – Additional Studies on Sunday Sermons

SundayAM: “Church Growth Part6” – It is important to overcome fears and be skilled at inviting people to hear the Gospel of Christ. “Come and See” lessons will give “10 Commandments of Inviting Visitors”.

Monday Scripture: Hebrews 10:24, Acts 8:35, and Acts 17:22

Key Idea: Consider the individual – their kids, uplifting spirit, or other trait – as you plan your invitation.

Study Questions: Define “consider” in Hebrews 10:24? Does every individual need to be handled exactly alike? Where did Philip start teaching in Acts 8:35? Where did Paul start teaching in Acts 17:22?

Faith Builder: If you ‘make a living’ of inviting others to hear the gospel, make 2021 your best year ever!

Tuesday Scripture: 2 Corinthians 5:10-14

Key Idea: The terror of the Lord’s judgment and our love for Christ compel us to share the Gospel.

Study Questions: Where must we all appear (v10)? What will be received in Judgment (v10)? Why did Paul persuade others to obey the gospel (v11)? What else compelled Paul to share the gospel (v14)?

Action Item: Do 7 total: either give “Come and See” cards or give good recommendations of Overland.

Wednesday Scripture: 1 Corinthians 3:16-17

Midweek Edification: You are the temple of God where He dwells so live holy! Bible study done?

SundayPM: “Jesus Prayed for You and Me” in John 17 as He outlines the relationship that a child of God is to have with this world. *No one* was a better example than Jesus of being “in” but “not of” the world.

Thursday Scripture: John 17:11-16

Key Idea: Jesus prayed for us to be protected from the world, have fulfilled joy, and to be kept from evil.

Study Questions: Where are believers “in” (v11)? Jesus “kept/guarded” who (v12)? What did Jesus want to be full-filled (vs13...how about you)? Does Jesus want His believers to be hermits (vs15)?

Godly Wisdom: Evil people of the world will corrupt and deceive with crooked speech (Proverbs 6:12).

Friday Scripture: John 17:17-22

Key Idea: Jesus prayed for us to be set apart by the truth, for all future believers, and unity of believers.

Study Questions: What sanctifies believers? What is truth (vs17)? Did Jesus set the best example (vs19)? Who all besides apostles did Jesus pray for (vs20)? How strong is the unity of believers to be (vs21)?

Prayer Idea: Pray for a new convert or teenager that needs more strength and protection from evil!

Saturday Scripture: 1 Corinthians 13:4-8

Sunday Prep: “Longsuffering...not provoked easy...thinks no evil” – show patience! Bible study done?
