Overland church of Christ Week36 2021 – Additional Studies on Sunday Sermons

SundayAM: “The Story of the Bible: Sin - How Did We Get Where We are Today?” – the accumulation of more and more sin (Romans 3:23) from Adam, Eve, Cain, Noah, and world got us to sinful state of today.

Monday Scripture: Proverbs 6:23-28

Key Idea: There is no way to play around and get close to sin without eventually falling and sinning.

Study Questions: Commandments from good parents are meant to do what (v23-24)? How is flattery and beauty used to lead to sin (v24-25)? What eventually happens if you get close to sin (v27-28)?

Consequences: Sin has consequences – guilty conscience, shame, hiding from God, cursed eternally.

Tuesday Scripture: Psalm 51:1-8

Key Idea: David had a guilty conscience and felt unclean because of his sin and needed God's cleansing.

Study Questions: What are some of the things that David asks of God in vs1-2? Was David feeling the burden and guilt of sin (v3-4)? How did David ask for cleansing (v7)? What did he want to feel (v8)?

Thanksgiving: We can't free ourselves from the bondage of sin – be abundantly thankful for our Savior.

Wednesday Scripture: 1 Thessalonians 5:12-13

Elders: Pray diligently for the elders – for their work, families and the church will be strong and unified.

SundayPM: “Unseen Things Last Forever” - Godhead (Father, Son, Holy Spirit), Word of God, Salvation of Christ, God's Comfort, Kingdom of God, Resurrected Body, Christian's Inheritance all are everlasting.

Thursday Scripture: 1 Peter 1:22-25

Key Idea: We have been born again through the incorruptible Word of God which abides forever!

Study Questions: How are souls purified (v22)? How are Christians to love one another (v22)? How are Christians born again (v23)? What fades away and what lives forever (v24-25)?

Allegiance: Righteousness exalts a nation so our allegiance is to God's ways to make our nation great.

Friday Scripture: Galatians 6:7-9

Key Idea: We either sow towards the flesh or sow towards spiritual things – and we reap what we sow.

Study Questions: Why is God not mocked (v7)? What do you reap (v7)? What does sowing to the flesh reap? What does sowing to the spirit reap? How can we stay motivated in doing good (v9)?

Good Deed: Send a note to a member you appreciate. Also send one to a member needing uplifted.

Saturday Scripture: Matthew 25:27

Parables: Any talent God has given you also includes an obvious way to make gain for the Lord's work.
