---

**SundayAM:** “Discontentment: Why?” (Steve Hardin) – we create discontentment when trying to satisfy spiritual with material, lop-sided priorities, trying to live life without God, and focus on the flesh.

---

### Monday Scripture: Luke 12:15-21

**Key Idea:** Your life consists of more than what you “possess” (which is only for a short while at best).

**Study Questions:** What are we to take heed to not let creep into our life? How much would the rich man be content with? What was the goal of the rich man after storing up? Where is true treasure stored?

**Action Item:** Do something today you think is lacking - “someone has to do it - might as well be you”.

### Tuesday Scripture: 1 Timothy 6:6-10

**Key Idea:** True gain/riches (personally or as a church) comes from godliness combined with contentment.

**Study Questions:** What is great gain? What 2 things should make us content? Is money the root of all evil? What is “love of money”? Can you be poor in this world and yet love money?

**Example:** No one can sin without it affecting other people.

### Wednesday Scripture: Philippians 4:10-13

**Midweek Prep:** I can do ALL things - THROUGH CHRIST - which strengtheneth me (Philippians 4:13).

---

**SundayPM:** “Discontentment: Devastating Results” (Steve Hardin) - Eve (perfect world), Lot (blessed with Abraham), Achan (on Canaan's border), and Judas (apostle of Christ) - lost all because of discontentment.

### Thursday Scripture: 2 Peter 2:6-9

**Key Idea:** Lot was bothered daily by the great sin in Sodom but the Lord delivered him.

**Study Questions:** What is the context of 2 Peter 2? What did God do to Sodom? How did Lot feel about the filth of Sodom? What does the Lord know how to do when it comes to godly people and temptation?

**Godly Wisdom:** Jealousy is when you count someone else's blessings instead of your blessings.

### Friday Scripture: Matthew 27:3-5

**Key Idea:** Judas had guilt about his betrayal of Christ driven by great covetousness and love of money.

**Study Questions:** What did Judas realize after condemning Christ? How did he try to “undo” his deed? Did Judas sin against Christ? What was the response of the leaders? What was the terrible end of Judas?

**Prayer Idea:** Ask for God's help to be content in whatever status that you are in.

### Saturday Scripture: Matthew 16:26

**Sunday Prep:** Your brethren in Christ are there for you to help be faithful and have Heaven as your home.
