

# Daily Reflections on God's Word - 2/6/2022

Overland church of Christ – Personal and Family Studies (Based on Prior Week's Sermons)

**Prior SundayAM:** "Preaching the Gospel of the Kingdom" (Jay Dixon) - kingdom preaching meant it was time for prophecies to be fulfilled, adoption one step closer, and people needed to repent and believe.

## Monday 2/7/2022: Luke 1:31-33

**Key Idea:** The coming of God's Kingdom was exciting because it would last forever.

**Actions and Roots:** "for His Kingdom there will be no end". Many times we rely on man and governments of men - these always come to failure. Let's also be this excited to be citizens of His eternal Kingdom.

**Daily Reading and Prayer:** Read **Judges 6-8 (Gideon)**. Use **Psalms 75-76** to guide your prayers.

## Tuesday 2/8/2022: Galatians 4:1-7

**Key Idea:** In the Kingdom, Christians have full adoption as children of the Father... heirs of salvation.

**Actions and Roots:** Families who adopt have an exciting time when they "get the call" - that new child can be brought home. Jesus "got the call" in the fullness of time so that we could be adopted.

**Daily Reading and Prayer:** Read **Judges 11:1-12:7 (Jephthah)**. Use **your prayer list** to guide your prayers.

## Wednesday 2/9/2022: Matthew 4:16

**Daily Reading and Prayer:** Read **Judges 13-16 (Samson)**. Use the **church directory** for prayers.

**Prior SundayPM:** "Wishing" (David McPherson) - wishing not enough...need teaching to convert, study to get knowledge, practice to get abilities, obedience to remove sin, and faithfulness to get to Heaven.

## Thursday 2/10/2022: 1 Timothy 4:15-16

**Key Idea:** Timothy was to diligently meditate on doctrine and live faithfully so that he could teach others.

**Actions and Roots:** You naturally grow in knowledge when you use something daily. Are you studying God's Word like this? You can't "wish" for Bible knowledge - you have to put in the time studying.

**Daily Reading and Prayer:** Read **Ruth 1-2**. Use **your prayer list** to guide your prayers.

## Friday 2/11/2022: Romans 6:16-18

**Key Idea:** When the Romans obeyed from the heart (in baptism vs 3-7), they were freed from sin.

**Actions and Roots:** It still takes obedience today to be saved (Hebrews 5:8-9). Paul was NOT told to "wish away" his sin, but "arise and \*be baptized, and wash away\* your sins" (Acts 22:16).

**Daily Reading and Prayer:** Read **Ruth 3-4**. Use **Psalms 77-78** to guide your prayers.

## Saturday 2/12/2022: 2 Timothy 2:24-26

**Daily Reading and Prayer:** Study next week's Bible classes. Use **your prayer list** to guide your prayers.
