# Survey of the Old Testament

**Genesis** - Book of beginnings. Adam and Eve, fall of man, redemption of man. History of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob.

**Exodus** - Moses and the deliverance from Egyptian bondage and the giving of the law.

**Leviticus** - Pertaining to the Levites. Law regarding the High Priest and priest. Sacrificial laws.

**Numbers** - 40 years of wandering in the wilderness because of disobedience.

**Deuteronomy** - Retelling of the law before Israel enters the promise land. The death of all the men of war who came out of Egypt.

**Joshua** - Change of leadership and the conquest of Canaan. Fall of Jericho and the settling into the promise land.

**Judges** - 300 years of 15 judges and deliverance from various oppressions by these judges.

**Ruth** - A Moabite woman who followed her mother-in-law back to her homeland and married Boas. She is also in the lineal descent of Jesus Christ.

**I Samuel** - Change of government from Judges to Kings. The life of Samuel, Saul and David.

**II Samuel** - Reign of David. The troubles and successes of David. David and Bathsheba.

**I Kings** - The selection of Solomon as king; his wisdom. The division of the kingdom.

**II Kings** - Continues with the divided kingdom, the prophet Elisha. The captivity of Israel by Assyria, and Judah by Babylon.

**I Chronicles** - Retelling of David for the purpose of educating another generation.

**II Chronicles** - The reign of Solomon and a history of Judah and the ten tribes fell to Assyria.

**Ezra** - The record of the 1st and 2nd groups returning from Babylonian captivity and the rebuilding of the temple.

**Nehemiah** - The third group returns to rebuild the walls and reestablish the sacred ordinances.

**Esther** - A beautiful Jewish woman who was held in captivity, became Queen and saved her people from destruction by the providence of God.

**Job** - A debate between God and Satan about a man of faith. Job's affliction and patience. Believed to be one of the oldest books of the Bible.

**Psalms** - Book of prayers and praises written by various men. Devotional thoughts that reach the hearts of mankind, and praises God.

**Proverbs** - A book of wisdom dealing with various circumstances that invade man's life.

**Ecclesiastes** - Vanities of life, man's whole duty before God,

**Song of Solomon** - Poem of love.

**Isaiah** - A period of time with kings of Judah, (Uzziah, Jotham, Ahaz and Hezekiah). A book of judgments and comfort, and rich Messianic prophecies. Woes pronounced on Assyria, Babylonia, Moab, Egypt and Edom.

**Jeremiah** - Captivity is coming. He was sensitive to the sinfulness of his nation against Jehovah. He was known as the weeping prophet.

**Lamentations** - Continuing the message of sorrow over Jerusalem. The ruin of the temple, city, and the people of Judah is discussed.

**Ezekiel** - Don't listen to the false prophets. Jerusalem must fall, nations must fall, and Jerusalem must be comforted.

**Daniel** - The account of four nations (Babylon, Medo-Persian, Greece and Roman). The lion's den and the fiery furnace. The kingdom of God was to be established during the fourth kingdom.

**Hosea** - The life of Hosea illustrates God's experience with Israel's spiritual adultery.

**Joel** - The day of the Lord, the prophet of Pentecost and the need of national repentance and its blessings.

**Amos** - The common prophet (herdsman). He was a prophet to Israel during peak of their prosperity. Because of their prosperity they had become spiritually dead.

**Obadiah** - The doom of Edom (**descendants of Esau**) because of their grudge against Israel.

**Jonah** - Mission of saving Nineveh. Jonah ran away from God, ran to God, ran with God, and ran ahead of God. Nineveh's repentance takes place.

**Micah** - Contemporary of Isaiah, he condemned their meaningless religious services. Foretells the coming of the Messianic kingdom in which righteousness shall Prevail.

**Nahum** - Prophecy to Nineveh that it is to be destroyed by both the Medes and Babylonians. Jonah had called Nineveh to repentance some 150 years earlier.

**Habakkuk**- How God uses nations. Babylon is rising to punish Judah. Time of Jeremiah.

**Zephaniah**- The searching judgments of God, against Israel and surrounding nations for their wickedness and a vision of the future glory of Israel. He gives a view of the restoration of the Jews to their homeland under Zerubbabel and Ezra.

**Haggai** - Colleague of Zechariah and co-laborer. The people had been attending to their projects and had forgotten the needs of the temple. He rebuked and admonished the people.

**Zechariah** - Contemporary of Haggai and co-laborer. He helped arouse the people to rebuild the temple. He returned with Zerubbabel and was an encourager.

**Malachi** - Almost a hundred years since Haggai and Zechariah the people had returned to their indifferent ways. The forerunner of Christ is prophesied. He showed the necessity of reforms before the coming of the Messiah.

# Survey of the New Testament

**Matthew** - This book gives the birth of Christ, His baptism, temptation and ministry. Written to the Jews about Christ being King. The sermon on the Mount is included. The beatitudes and the Lord's prayer. Also found is a passage on future events.

**Mark** - This book was written for the Roman readers. This book centers on Christ and the sacrifice and service of the believer to Him.

**Luke** - The theme of this book is also Christ. Christ is spoken of as the Son of Man and gives us a view of Christ's compassion. This book was written with the Greek (Gentile) in mind.

**John** - This book is addressed to all and deals mostly with the deity of Christ. It is a book about Him and about having faith in Him. He is the Son of God. Seven miracles of Christ: water into wine; the healing of the nobleman's son; healing of the paralyzed person; feeding of the multitude; walking on water; opening the blind man's eyes and the rising of Lazarus from the dead. The Holy Spirit is spoken of and the new birth.

**Acts** - This book talks of the gospel of Christ and its deliverance to the world. Conversions and the beginning of the church. The book talks of Christianity in Jerusalem, Palestine, and Syria. This is a record of the Apostles as they journeyed to various parts of the world to deliver the message of the Gospel.

**Romans** - This is a book of justification by faith and what happens if faith is not present. All have sinned. The righteousness of God is shown and many things are discussed relating to Christianity.

**I Corinthians** - This letter written by Paul deals with spirituality and morality and their lack of such. It speaks of the judgment seat of Christ, the temple of the Holy Spirit, the Lord's Supper, Love, miraculous gifts, and the resurrection.

**II Corinthians** - This letter is written by Paul from Ephesus defending his apostleship. He also speaks of the grace of giving.

**Galatians** - Paul's letter about justification by faith. There is only one way for man to come to God and that is through Jesus Christ. Warning against false teachers and reverting to Judaism.

**Ephesians** - This letter was written while Paul was in prison and speaks of God's purpose in establishing the church of Christ. Christ is spoken of as head of the church. The church is spoken of as the building and temple of God and the church as the bride of Christ. Emphasis is on Unity!

**Philippians** - Paul was in prison when he wrote this letter. This book speaks of self-denial, giving up self for Christ; it speaks of the importance of prayer. Praying always, and in all things giving thanks.

**Colossians** - Paul also wrote this letter from prison. This book talks about the importance and supreme nature of Christ. We can find all things in Christ. In Christ, we are drawn into union.

**I Thessalonians** - Paul speaks of his thankfulness to the church and talks about hope, the last days and, the day of the Lord.

**II Thessalonians** - Paul speaks out against idle talkers and clears up the message pertaining to the day of the lord in relation to the present and exhorts the people to pray and stand in faithfulness and obedience.

**I Timothy** - The main idea of this book is for Timothy to fight the good fight. We are told how to act in the house of God. Rules and structure are given for bishops/elders and deacons of the church. This book also speaks of the last days and of caring for others and how to use money.

**II Timothy** - In this book Timothy is told how to be a good and faithful soldier of Christ. The book speaks of the last days, inspiration of the Words of God, and the crown of righteousness. This book calls upon Timothy to be courageous, faithful, a strong and loyal servant to God, and to fulfill his ministry.

**Titus** - In this book we have the qualifications for elders, operation of the church and the duties of the minister. An exhortation to be wary of false teachings and with special emphasis on good works.

**Philemon** - This letter is also one that was written while Paul was in prison. This is a very personal letter. It gives praise to Philemon, a plea, a pledge and speaks of personal things concerning Philemon and his run-away slave Onesimus.

**Hebrews** - This book speaks of the greatness of Christ. It is a book of betters, dealing with the greatness of the new covenant over the old. This book also describes faith and gives a roll call of the heroes of faith.

**James** - The book of James talks about the practical faith of the believer. We are told how faith and works stand together. Faith and works are the two main points of the book followed closely by the tongue.

**I Peter** - This book calls upon the believer to be a follower of Christ's example. This book tells us that grace includes security, submission, obedience, suffering, service, growth, and love.

**II Peter** - We have all things that pertain to life and godliness. Add the graces of a Christian and do not fall. This book talks of faith and false teachings. It gives the characteristics of false teachers and a look at the future.

**I John** - This book is devoted to the welfare of the spiritual life of the believer. It is full of comparisons of dark to light, the love of the world, and the love of God. It speaks of the children of God and the children of Satan. It speaks of the spirit of the antichrist and the spirit of Christ.

**II John** - Walk in the commandments of Christ and do not wish well, the false teacher. To assist a false teacher is to partake in their evil deeds.

**III John** - This is a personal letter addressed to Gaius. It speaks of godly living, the treatment of traveling ministers, and the selfishness of Diotrephes.

**Jude** - The purpose of the writing of this book is showing a defense of the faith developed by the apostles against false teachings springing up in the churches. The writer exposes the false teachers and exhorts the believers.

**Revelation** - Jesus Christ is the center of this book and this book is His revelation written by John. It speaks of things that were to happen THEN (very shortly). It calls upon Christians to be faithful even if it costs them their lives.

- 19 Now the works of the flesh are manifest, which are these; Adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lasciviousness,
- 20 Idolatry, witchcraft, hatred, variance, emulations, wrath, strife, seditions, heresies,
- 21 Envyings, murders, drunkenness, revellings and such like: of the which I tell you before, as I have also told you in time past, that they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God.
- 22 But the fruit of the Spirit, is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith,
- 23 Meekness, temperance: against such there is no law.

## **Galatians 6:7**

- 7 Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap.

## **Ephesians 4:11-16**

- 11 And he gave some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers;
- 12 For the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ:
- 13 Till we all come in the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fulness of Christ:
- 14 That we henceforth be no more children, tossed to and fro, and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the sleight of men, and cunning craftiness, whereby they lie in wait to deceive;
- 15 But speaking the truth in love, may grow up into him in all things, which is the head, even Christ:
- 16 From whom the whole body fitly joined together and compacted by that which every joint supplieth, according to the effectual working in the measure of every part, maketh increase of the body unto the edifying of itself in love.

## **Ephesians 4:32**

- 32 And be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you.

- 1 Children, obey your parents in the Lord: for this right.
- 2 Honor thy father and mother; which is the first commandment with promise;
- 3 That it may be well with thee, and thou mayest live long on the earth.

7 And to godliness brotherly kindness; and to brotherly kindness charity.  
8 For if these things be in you, and abound, they make you that ye shall neither be barren nor unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ.  
9 But he that lacketh these things is blind, and cannot see afar off, and hath forgotten that he was purged from his old sins.  
10 Wherefore the rather, brethren, give diligence to make your calling and election sure: for if ye do these things ye shall never fall.  
11 For so an entrance shall be ministered unto you abundantly into the everlasting kingdom of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

**II Peter 1:20-21**

- 20 Knowing this first, that no prophecy of the scripture is of any private interpretation.  
21 For the prophecy came not in old time by the will of man: but holy men of God spake as they were moved by the Holy Ghost.

**II Peter 3:9**
