- 5:1-3 Give ear to my prayer- to God
- 5:4-6 No evil dwells with You- describes wicked
- 5:7-8 I will enter Your house- to God
- 5:9-10 Their tongue is disaster- describes wicked
- 5:11-12 Let who take refuge in You glad- to God

PSALM 5:7

- 1. But as for me... I will enter Your house-
Contrast to vs. 4-6, 9-10
- But as for me- Joshua 24:14-15
- Enter Your house- Ps. 23:6; 26:8; 27:4; 84:10
- This demands way of life- Ps. 15; 24:3-4

PSALM 5:7

- 2. By Your abundant lovingkindness
- Abundant= “multitude” vs. 10
- Lovingkindness- 128x in Psalms
- Luke 7:40-42; Romans 3:13; 2:16

PSALM 5:7

- **3. At Your holy temple, I will bow in reverence...**
- **God's lovingkindness connected with worship- Ex. 34:5-8; II Chron. 7:1-3**
- **God's mercy and reverence for God- Ps. 130:3-4**
