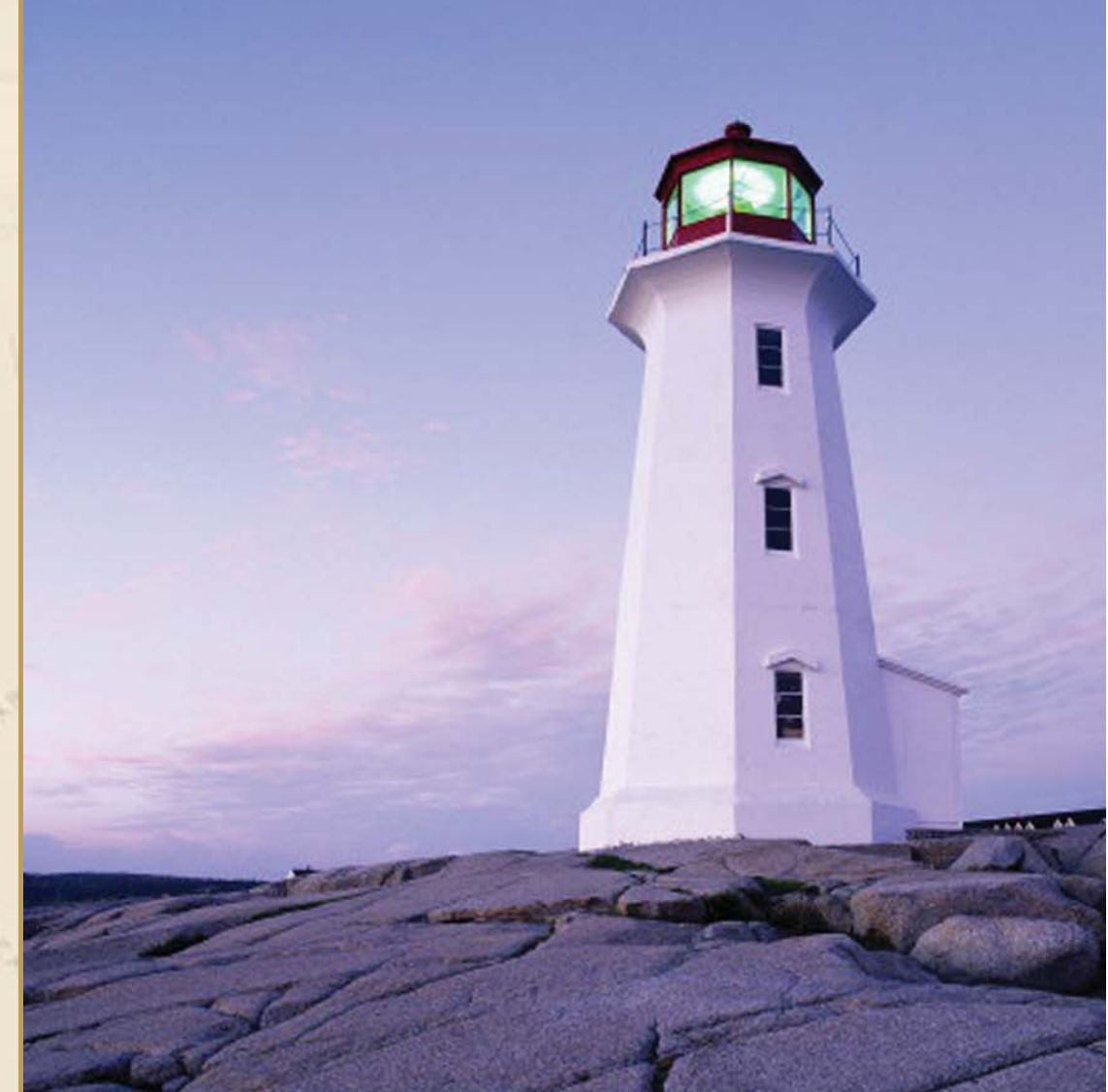

Pondering the Proverbs 22
Create in Me a Clean Heart

The poetic strains of the Psalm 51 calls out to God that His righteousness would correct our mis-guided ways. A popular song based on the Psalm calls unto God to break our hearts and break down the barriers between us. These words reflect a humble spirit before God. "Create in me a clean heart, O God; and renew a right spirit within me" (Psalm 51:10). In our pilgrimage through this land we all admit we need a renewal of spirit at various points in our lives. As we make this cry unto God let us consider carefully that we make not this cry in vain. We find that the renewal and clean heart petitioned of God simply does not suddenly envelope us and take away our control. One of the great and mysterious gifts with which God has blessed us is the power of decision. Since God choose not to over-ride the will of man, let us examine the cry of the Psalm in light of the wisdom of Proverbs 16. The powerful Proverbs illuminate our understanding as we approach God in prayer and song.

The preparations of the heart in man, and the answer of the tongue, is from the LORD. All the ways of a man are clean in his own eyes; but the LORD weigheth the spirits. Commit thy works unto the LORD, and thy thoughts shall be established. The LORD hath made all things for himself: yea, even the wicked for the day of evil. Every one that is proud in heart is an abomination to the LORD: though hand join in hand, he shall not be unpunished. By mercy and truth iniquity is purged: and by the fear of the LORD men depart from evil. (Proverbs 16:1-6)

It would appear that Solomon is communicating that the heart of man must be willing to accept the plans of Jehovah God. How is it that God communicates His plan that we may accept it? How does He enter into us that we may have the answer that is from Him?

Man has skewed reasoning based on a myriad of factors. Solomon reminds us that all our ways seem clean to us. It is the Lord who weighs in the balance righteousness versus evil. When we truly commit to humbly following God then the very thoughts of God become our thoughts and our path is established. God values Man with a love that we cannot comprehend. That love, however, does not write us a blank check. Man is still the creature, created by God for God. We must remember our place before the One Who gave us all we have.

It is by the mercy and truth of God that our relationship can be restored after we have fallen by our own desires into the mires of sin. The psalmist cries for mercy before God. "Cast me not away from Thy presence; and take not thy Holy Spirit from me. Restore unto me the joy of Thy salvation; and uphold me with thy free spirit" (Psalm 51:11-12). Pride has devised a plethora of directions pointing to salvation but leading to a dead end. It is by a respect of the authority and power of God that man realizes his position and looks unto God for the direction of truth.

God provides us with the direction of truth through His plenary Word. It is the power of God's Word that breaks the heart of man preparing it for the work of a thankful and penitent creature. Once having found that treasure, it is too precious to hide, it must be shared. "Then will I teach transgressors thy ways; and sinners shall be converted unto thee" (Psalm 51:13).

As we cry unto Him to create within us a clean heart and restore righteousness, let us do so while enveloping ourselves in study and meditation of His word. "But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him" (Hebrews 11:6).
