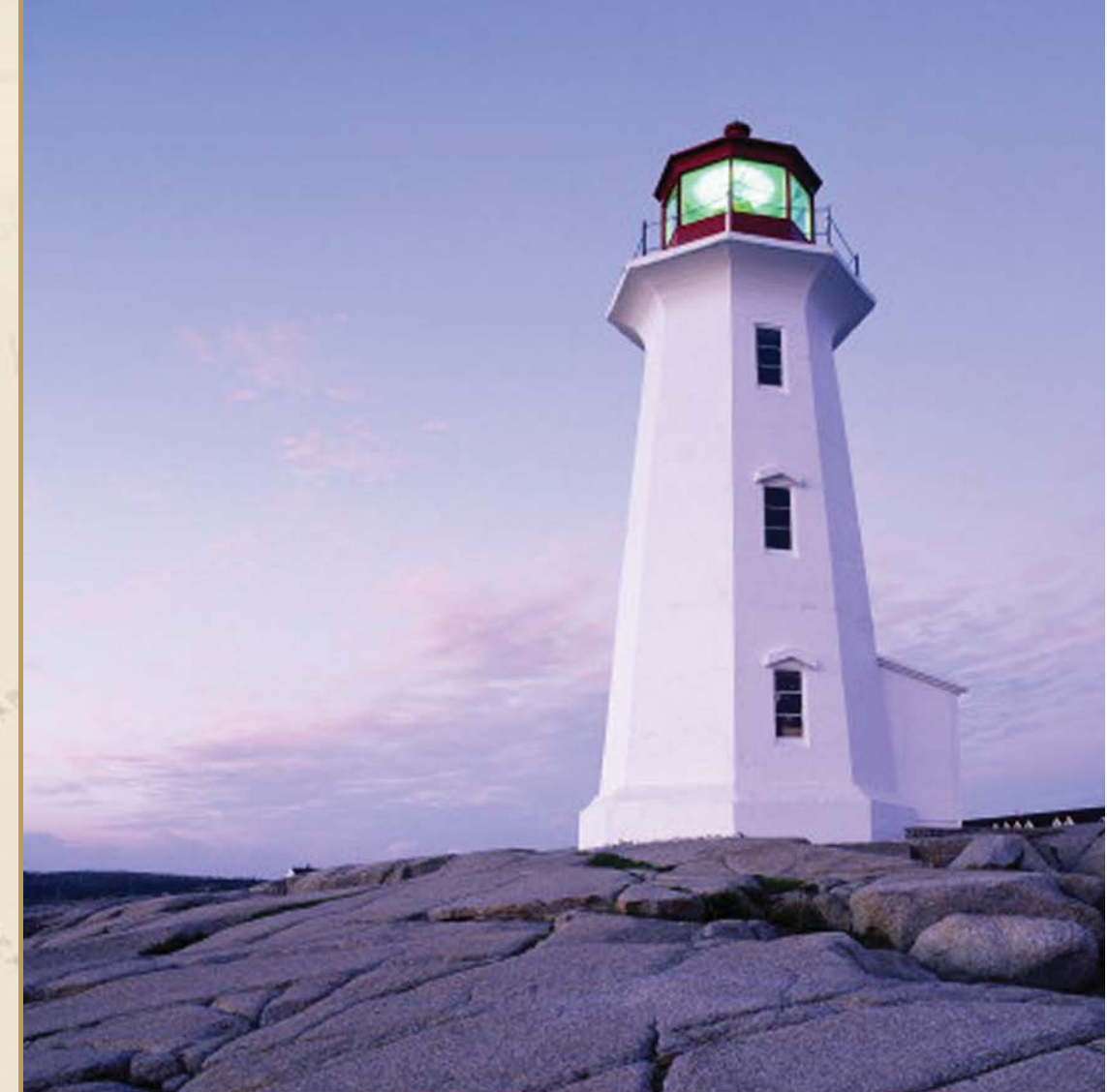

Falling Rock

The car wound it's way up Tennessee's Mont Eagle, and the signs say your traveling West but it seems very much like northbound travel. The children stretch their seat belts to see out the windows as the road winds up the majestic mountain. The rock is beautiful along side the road. Brief clearings reveal a sprawling valley. Suddenly the youngest girl shouts, "LOOK OUT!" Dad hits the brakes looking for the calamity approaching.... but nothing. Only angry drivers behind. Dad, in a stern and angry voice said, "What on earth is the matter? There is nothing to look out for." The little girl responds, "I saw a sign that said, 'Falling Rock', so I thought you'd better look out daddy." Dad quips back, "Little girl.. I've been driving over this mountain for over 20 years and never had to worry about falling rock. Don't be silly. We would know if the conditions were right for rock to fall." "But daddy," she says, "Why do they put up signs if the rocks don't fall?" After a breath for patience he said, "Rocks do fall once in a great, long while so they want you to know the potential exists. But dear, its not likely." The little girl then said, "We could get killed if rocks fall on the road." Dad says nothing and appears busy driving. After a short pause, the little girl mumbles, "I bet it's a big deal when the rocks fall. So we need to be safe."

Oddly enough on the return trip there was a great deal of construction traffic on the mountain. Having forgotten about her "sign" concerns on the trip up, the little girl asks, "Dad, why are there so many trucks? They are slowing us down." Really wishing she had not asked, he takes a breath and says, "Dear, there was a rock slide yesterday." She thought for a moment. Then she said, "I never heard of a rock slide. Is that a slide for trucks?" "No", dad was quick to respond and then he admitted. "You see dear, a rock slide is when rocks fall onto the road." "Ohhh"... she said slowly. "So that means the falling rock sign was right?" Mom is now giggling at the discovery. Dad replies in a sing-song voice, "Yes dear the sign was right." Tapping her lips with her fingers she asks, "Dad, did you know the conditions were right for the rock to fall?" Rolling his eyes dad replies, "No dear, I did not know." Still tapping her lips she said, "Soooo... saying 'Look Out' was the right thing to say right dad?" After another breath for patience dad replied, "You could have said 'Look Out' there was no need to shout." The now silent little girl just smiled out the window still tapping her lips.

In this situation it would be interesting to know how differently the conversation would have gone if the little girl had just said "Look Out" instead of shouting it. The sign was basically saying "Look Out" but since no one seemed to react to the sign the little girl brought it to life.

God's word is all too often treated like the many drivers that climb Mont Eagle every day. The yellow sign warning to move with caution because danger may be lurking ahead is often over looked as being reactionary. Many look at God's warnings the same way, too reactionary. Often we think, "I know God is looking out for me but I can handle this." Yet, our society is scared with the results of our not listening to God or clamoring that "God did not say we can't". Notice the warning sign that God gives us.



Now the works of the flesh are evident: sexual immorality, impurity, sensuality, idolatry, sorcery, enmity, strife, jealousy, fits of anger, rivalries, dissensions, divisions, envy, drunkenness, orgies, and things like these. I warn you, as I warned you before, that those who do such things will not inherit the kingdom of God. (Galatians 5:19-21)

Before the list it seems interesting that the "works of the flesh are evident." Then after the list we find the phrase "and things like these." God is warning us to watch and steer clear of these things because these things will cost us our souls. It is true that we can ignore His warning and sail right along life's road. When we are confident in our own ways we play right into Satan's trap. We ignore the pebbles falling, ("things like these") but then the rock slide brings tragedy.

Therefore, stay awake, for you do not know on what day your Lord is coming. But know this, that if the master of the house had known in what part of the night the thief was coming, he would have stayed awake and would not have let his house be broken into. Therefore, you also must be ready, for the Son of Man is coming at an hour you do not expect. (Matthew 24:42-44)

What a tragic thing it would be to ignore God's "Falling Rock" sign and be lost for eternity. God's desire is for your soul to be safe and arrive in Heaven.
