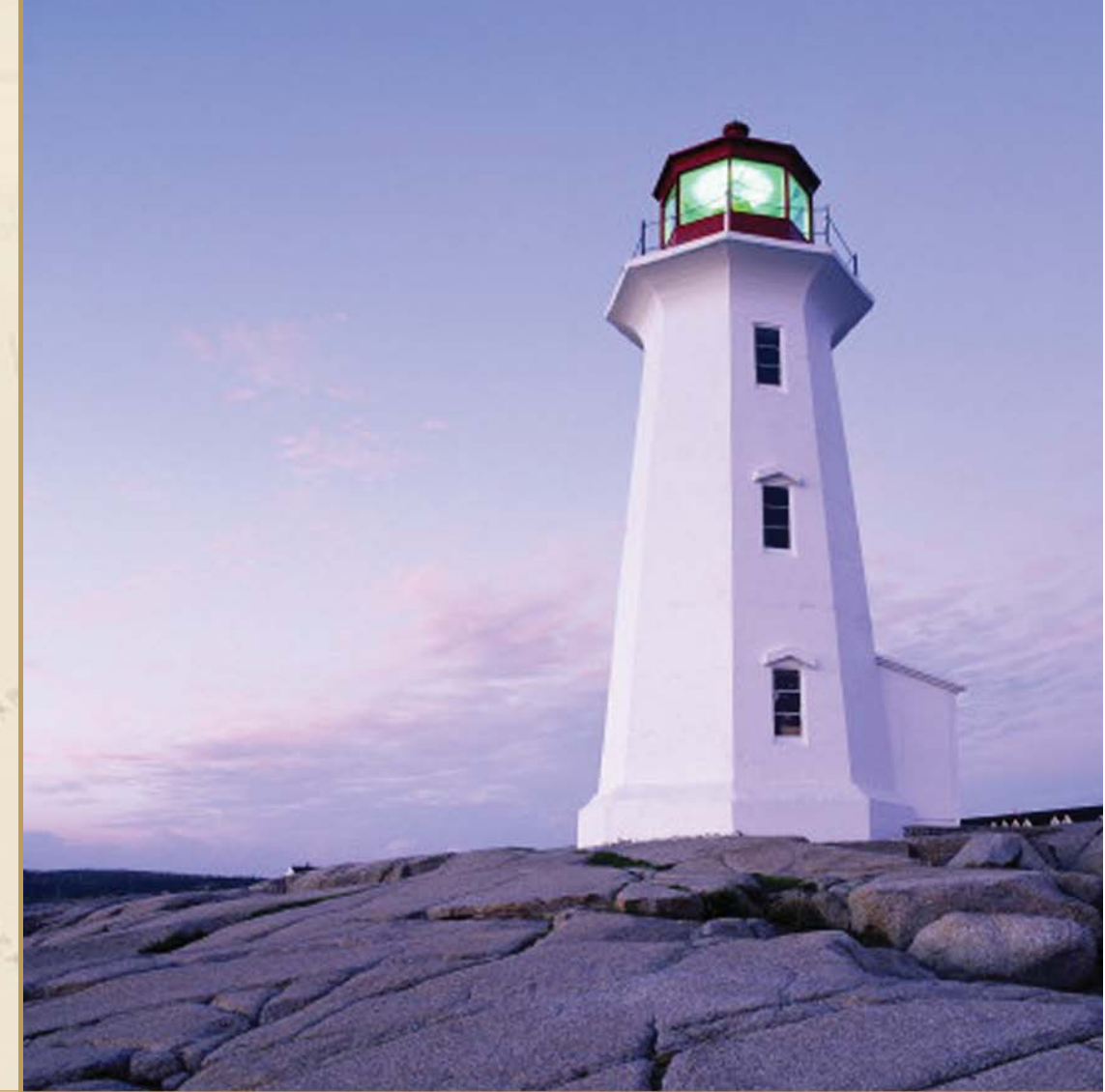

Church Family News

We continue to work with young Daniel and Donna Griffin in the aftermath of losing their child. I have accompanied them to all their meetings with the hospital so far as the investigation continues. They have not responded to my efforts to set up a weekly time to either study with them or engage in some marriage enrichment sessions and I don't want to push too hard for either while their attention is focused on finding closure after the death of Arianna. But I am still hopeful that something productive will come out of this tragedy in the long run.

We have also had the opportunity to work with Daniel Amaboeng's family during his recent illness. Daniel has undergone a couple of surgeries and has experienced difficulties during his recovery. He has not been able to work or worship with us for a few months now but through visits and financial help we have been able to build a relationship with his wife and kids that had not been possible before.

Daniel's wife, Mercy, worships with one of the Pentecostal denominations and, up to this point, has resisted any discussions but these recent events have softened any barriers that are there. Graham has been studying with Daniel every Monday to help keep him spiritually fed during his absence.

Another one of our African members, Love Johnson, has needed much care and love during the death of her mum in Nigeria. The situation for Love was exacerbated by the fact she couldn't even go over to attend the funeral due to the dangers of the area where she lives. Love really struggled for a few weeks but she is doing much better now and is thankful for such a strong Christian family around her.

The best of the church family news is that we have a new sister. Sophie Knott was baptised into Christ on the 16th February. She had been invited along about a year and a half ago by Graham and Elizabeth's oldest daughter, Megan. Nicole has been studying with her for the last few weeks and continues to do so now as she grows in her relationship with the Lord. We are proud of the decision she has made in the face of some discouragement from those around her and we are also proud of the impact our own young people are having on the lives of their friends and loved ones.
