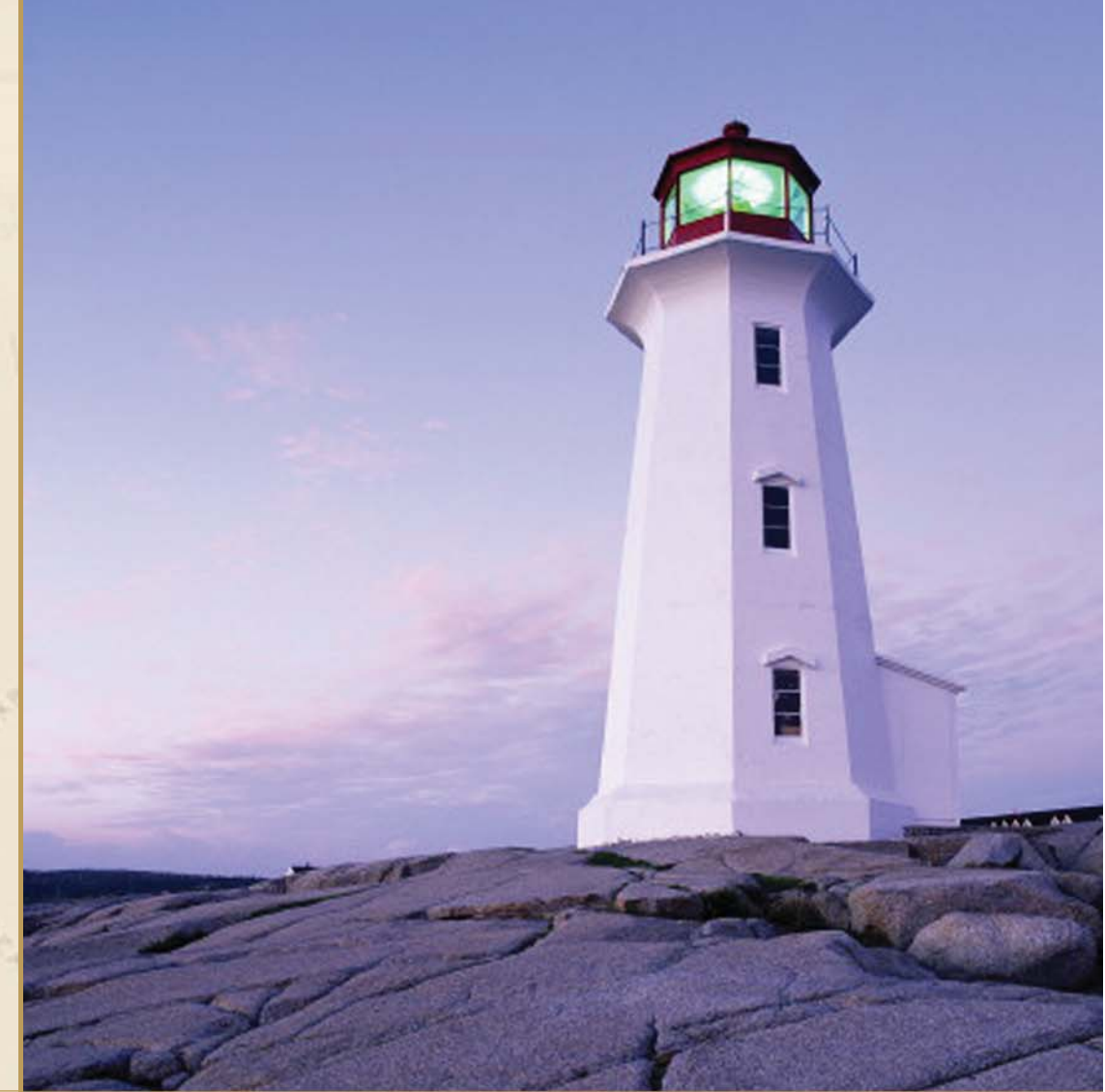

Majorous Interuptous

Many looking at the title of this article would think the typist dropped something on the keyboard. However, we should consider the poetic license of the title in light of the "Parable of the Soils". Matthew chapter seven brings us a parable of Jesus that uses the principle of sowing seed to provide us a comparison for the reception of the Gospel. The first few verses indicate that some seed fell by the wayside or landed on top of the pathway used by the sower. This hardened ground served as a plate to feed the birds as they consumed the seed and it never had a chance to grow. We also find some seed fell on shallow soil where no root could be established and when the heat came the fledgling plant withered away. Then we arrive at verse seven. "And some fell among thorns; and the thorns sprung up, and choked them". Matthew 7:7 is a verse of major importance for the believer today.

Jesus explained the comparison or meaning of this portion of the parable at Matthew 7:22. "He also that received seed among the thorns is he that hears the word; and the care of this world, and the deceitfulness of riches, choke the word, and he becomes unfruitful". We can find our Christianity in "Majorous Interuptus" mode while doing right things. Providing for one's family, others and one's self is certainly a principle we can find within the pages of God's word. We find our Christianity interrupted when we forget the purpose of earthly work.

God placed Adam in the garden and gave him the first job.

"And the Lord God took the man, and put him into the garden of Eden to dress it and to keep it. And the Lord God commanded the man, saying, Of every tree of the garden you may freely eat: But of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, you shall not eat of it: for in the day that you eat thereof you shall surely die" (Genesis 2:15-16).

Soon thereafter, God put Adam into a deep sleep and took a rib from him creating woman. The Genesis narrative takes us quickly to Eve's interaction with the serpent and soon her relationship with God was interrupted. What were the thorns and weeds that choked the faith of Adam and Eve? Again, poetic license... the "I wants." Instead of keeping God at the center of their focus when they were so blessed, they wanted more things instead of more God. They had never seen mansion sized homes or luxurious automobiles but they knew the power of God. Satan tempted them with the ability to know what God knows and used the victim syndrome to motivate them into action. Satan accused God of holding Adam and Eve down. Today, he tempts us by showing us the wealth of others. He whispers in our ears, "You are as good as they, why don't you have those things? The resounding answer is "Work!"

It is a good thing to work and we know that without work we should not eat, (2 Thessalonians 3:10). Work, however, can become some of our great weeds. We can be wise in finance and store up much with the idea that retirement will be a great time of travel and leisure. Certainly we realize we should not be foolish and wasteful but balanced and godly priorities must be the guide. Jesus provides another warning about "Majorous Interuptus."

And he told them a parable, saying, "The land of a rich man produced plentifully, and he thought to himself, 'What shall I do, for I have nowhere to store my crops?' And he said, 'I will do this: I will tear down my barns and build larger ones, and there I will store all my grain and my goods. And I will say to my soul, "Soul, you have ample goods laid up for many years; relax, eat, drink, be merry.'" But God said to him, 'Fool! This night your soul is required of you, and the things you have prepared, whose will they be?' So is the one who lays up treasure for himself and is not rich toward God (Luke 12:16-21).

When we allow the cares of this life to interrupt our relationship with God we have fallen for a very cunning ploy of the Devil. Since Satan is so very deceiving, how do we know when we are being tricked?

Consider where your time has been spent this week. How much time reading the newspaper, watching the television news, and/or reading internet news? What is your habit in getting the latest world information? Now consider how much time you spent reading God's word. Next consider how much you know about your favorite television show or your favorite sports team. Then consider how much you know about biblical characters. For most of us, these very ideas strike a nerve and we can get angry. At whom should we be angry? Cain became angry at God and Abel but who was responsible? Cain's "I want", got in the way as a weed that distanced him from God. What is your, "I want" or "Majorous Interuptus" that separates you from God?

Today is the day to weed the garden and nurture the seeds of God's word.
