At the Feet of Jesus

Sitting in a college classroom, John is enthralled with the instructor's presentation. John thinks to himself, "This is it! Soon, I will be able to do what the instructor is demonstrating. I, too, will be able to practice this and earn a great sum!" John has really come to appreciate his instructor. Mr. Bailey has been in the business a long time. He knows the ups and downs, ins and outs of the business, and because he has lived the business, Mr. Bailey easily gives encouraging thoughts of facing the difficulties that will arise. John finds himself patient but a bit anxious as the lesson comes.

The instructor, Mr. Bailey, has a severe communication problem because of an awful disease. By no fault of his own, he contracted a nervous system disorder that has rendered his speech slow and difficult, to say the least. Even so, his communication difficulties have little impact on the listeners. They value what he has to say, with no regard to the physical delivery.

Most likely we have all experienced a teacher in a similar way. The teacher's information is so important to us that we are willing to suffer through long lectures and awkward demonstrations. Why is that material so good? Because we want it.

In as much as we want to be successful in this life, what about success in eternity? Do we dare consider the existence that awaits us on the other side of death? Have we allowed Satan to place doubt in our minds about the reality of that existence? While at the funeral home or in the graveyard, have you ever stared at the remains and said to yourself, "That's it. They are not here anymore. It's all over." The Devil likes to take truths and bend them just a bit in order to damage your faith. The person who lies in the grave has come to the end of physical life's time-line; therefore, the spirit has left the body. It is not, however, all over. It is just the beginning because death in this life opens the door to eternity. There are many things we do not yet understand because we have not been there.

Jesus has provided a key to eternity in Heaven. Would you be willing to sit at His feet and consider His words? He tells us, "Think not that I am come to send peace on earth: I came not to send peace, but a sword" (Matthew 10:34). The problem arises because those who were used to doing what they thought was God's plan didn't want to make any changes. They ignored the fact that Christ fulfilled the very prophecy they claimed to hold in such high regard. The religious leaders of Jesus' day also had introduced so many of their own traditions that the typical Jew could not differentiate that which was holy and given by God from that which was introduced by man. Could we be suffering from the same behavior today?

Jesus also told us, "...they that are whole have no need of the physician, but they that are sick: I came not to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance" (Mark 2:17). For this reason, Jesus was accused by the religious leaders of "slumming". Why would He go to the lowly of people and eat? He went because they needed to hear the whole Gospel. Jesus knew those who were lost needed to hear and many would listen because it was important to them. A comfortable place to sit with no distractions would not have been common and still it was important to them.

The will of God was important to more than just the Jews. "For I came down from heaven, not to do mine own will, but the will of Him that sent me" (John 6:38). Jesus made the Will of the Father, Job One! Because Jesus decided to make the Father's Will His top priority, He was successful. "This Jesus hath God raised up, whereof we all are witnesses. Therefore, being by the right hand of God exalted, and having received of the Father the promise of the Holy Ghost, he hath shed forth this, which ye now see and hear" (Acts 2:32-33). Since Jesus is now on the right hand of God (Acts 7:55-56; Romans 8:34; Colossians 3:1; 1 Peter 3:22), would it not seem wise to learn from Him?

Jesus has invited you to join Him in Heaven. When we sit at His feet, the Savior begins with lesson one. Humility. We must humble ourselves before Him in order to understand that which the Father would ask of us. "For it is written, As I live, saith the Lord, every knee shall bow to me, and every tongue shall confess to God" (Romans 14:11).

To humble ourselves to Him is to listen to what He says. When we sit at the feet of Jesus, we first learn that we can fool ourselves into believing we have put His Will first. However, when we look at what we practice in our lives, we get a different picture. We find reasons to justify the difference. This week, let's challenge ourselves to change our perception of God's Word from something that we already know to something that will help us grow.
