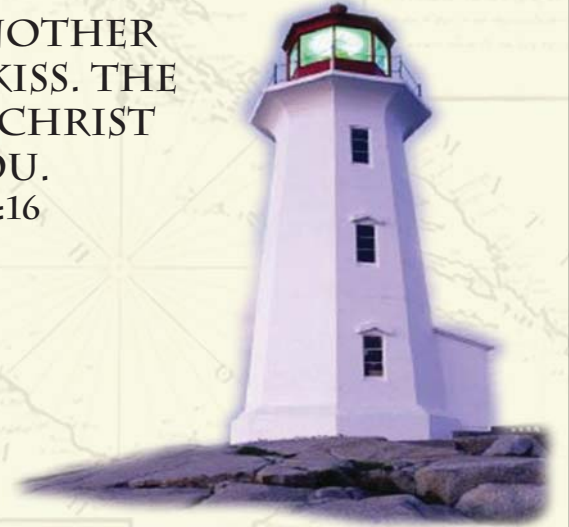

Life Changed in a Moment

The first day of the week is a day honored by Christians who gather to worship the mighty God. Songs of thanksgiving, praise and adoration ring out from homes and church buildings large and small. (1 Corinthians 15:14, Hebrews 2:12, Ephesians 5:19, Colossians 3:16, Matthew 26:30).

Prayers are offered for the sick, shut-in and unfaithful. Thanks as well as petitions are offered in those prayers. (Luke 6:28; 10:2; 11:1ff, 1 Thessalonians 5:17).

Christians gather around the Lord's Table as they did every Sunday in the first century. Often passages are read and then there are prayers offered giving thanks for Jesus' dying on the cross and for the bread and fruit of the vine. (Acts 20:7; 1 Corinthians 11:23-26).

Prayers are lifted in thanksgiving for our physical blessings and opportunities to support the work of the church are offered. (2 Corinthians 9:7).

Preachers stand behind pulpits and proclaim the truth to audiences, some of whom are enthusiastically engaged, others are present in body but not in mind. After all the scriptural activities of worship are engaged an invitation is offered. A call is made to one and all who find themselves at enmity with God after having heard His word. Within that invitation to obey the Gospel (2 Thessalonians 1:8) the issue of time is sometimes discussed. We do not know how much time we have but in the grand scheme of things our time is brief. (James 4:14). A plea is made and a song is sung.

It's a great day when someone responds. Perhaps a soul needs to be saved in the waters of baptism (Mark 16:16, Acts 2:38). Still another wayfaring soul needs the prayers of his brothers and sisters because temptation led him away from his God.

On Sunday, September 24th, 2017 in Antioch, Tennessee the normalcy of New Testament worship was interrupted as never before. It was not an unruly child or someone snoring, it was a gunman. The peace of worship was shattered with the sound of gunfire at the Burnett Chapel congregation. Seven were victims of the gunman and one 39 year old lady lost her life in the parking lot. The remaining six were taken to area hospitals.

Life on this corner will never be the same. This tragic reminder calls our attention to the brevity of life. Each day we encounter a host of opportunities for life as we know it to change or even to end. As much as we should enjoy the time God has given us, the way we define the word "enjoy" is critical. The same media channels that brought us the story also bring us messages from those who would sell us things to destroy us. Paul gave the church at Galatia a list of those things that would destroy us eternally.

Now the works of the flesh are evident, which are: adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lewdness, idolatry, sorcery, hatred, contentions, jealousies, outbursts of wrath, selfish ambitions, dissensions, heresies, envy, murders, drunkenness, revelries, and the like; of which I tell you beforehand, just as I also told you in time past, that those who practice such things will not inherit the kingdom of God. (Galatians 5:19-21)

An honest look at this list reveals that these things will destroy us physically also. Even the emotional damages wreak havoc on the body. When we come to the realization that we have been sold "magic beans" by Satan we can do something about it.

In an instant we can make a decision to follow Jesus. All too often we focus on the moment in time when lives were changed for the worse. What about the moment in time when lives changed for the better? You can make a decision at this very moment that will affect you for eternity. If life ended in the next moment, would you be ready to meet God? If not, life can change in a moment for the believer. Put God first now.
