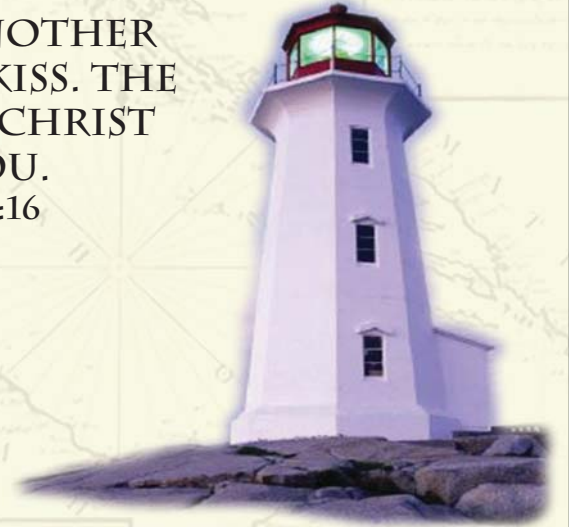

Go for a Walk with God

Our country seems to be in turmoil. Some people clamor that our children belong to the community rather than to the parents. They use the heart wrenching story of the hungry. The cry is made for government intervention. Government should take the responsibility for all the children since a few are found in want. Others cry out for the raped and incestuously violated and use the pitiable as the flag for abortion rights. Here is where we hide murder to cover sin and call it choice. Then those who live the decadent lifestyles hide under the skirt of equal rights to promote freedom without responsibility. Truth has been labeled hate speech. The militant extremists who use evil to eradicate evil are the ones put forth as conservative, old school and square. Extremists do not represent the moral conservatives in our society. Hatred, however, is fueled for those who speak the truth in love. Morality and common sense are squelched along with the very mention of God. In order to confuse the children even more, government leaders call for prayer and claim it as their own. The tornado of confusion keeps us spinning like a weather vane in a hurricane. Where will it end?

A simple walk with God will restore my peace. Matthew chapter fourteen tells us of the miraculous feeding of five thousand men beside the women and children. After seeing that amazing act of love and confirmation from the Father that Jesus is the Son of God, the disciples were sent ahead by water. Jesus sent the multitude away and then went alone to pray. This was not a prayer of convenience. This was not a prayer made while doing something else. This was not a prayer in a time of emergency. Jesus took the time to be alone with God. The devil wants to keep you busy. He will tell you that "Post-It Note" prayer is just fine. Jesus set an example for us that prayer needs some concentrated time. Yes, prayer when we have a moment, or while our hands are doing something else, or especially in time of emergency is acceptable. However, there is also a need for the healthy Christian to take a walk with God. Notice the next event Matthew records.

And straightway Jesus constrained his disciples to get into a ship, and to go before him unto the other side, while he sent the multitudes away. And when he had sent the multitudes away, he went up into a mountain apart to pray: and when the evening was come, he was there alone. But the ship was now in the midst of the sea, tossed with waves: for the wind was contrary. And in the fourth watch of the night Jesus went unto them, walking on the sea. And when the disciples saw him walking on the sea, they were troubled, saying, It is a spirit; and they cried out for fear. But straightway Jesus spake unto them, saying, Be of good cheer; it is I; be not afraid. And Peter answered him and said, Lord, if it be thou, bid me come unto thee on the water. And he said, Come. And when Peter was come down out of the ship, he walked on the water, to go to Jesus. But when he saw the wind boisterous, he was afraid; and beginning to sink, he cried, saying, Lord, save me. And immediately Jesus stretched forth his hand, and caught him, and said unto him, O thou of little faith, wherefore didst thou doubt? And when they were come into the ship, the wind ceased. Then they that were in the ship came and worshipped him, saying, Of a truth thou art the Son of God. (Matthew 14:22-33)

The disciples were afraid because the sea was rough and they saw a ghost walking on the water toward them. They must have felt as if they were in the very hand of evil. But a voice of comfort came across the waves identifying Himself as Jesus. Peter stepped forward and asked to meet Jesus on the water. Peter stepped out of the boat. With his eyes on the Master he too walked on the water. Could you imagine the comfort and peace of knowing you were in the Hands of God? The frightful waves and weather grabbed Peter's attention and with his eyes off the Master he began to sink. Notice that Peter called out to Jesus and was caught by the Savior. We find at least two important lessons in Matthew fourteen.

First, we must take time to commune with God. We need to pray and meditate on His Word. Second, we must keep our eyes on the Master when faced with the storms of life. If the storms frighten us and we look to ourselves for the answer we will sink. It is great comfort to know that He hears us when we call. Plan right now to take some time and put the world on hold. God is the only One that can restore peace in a stormy world. Keep your eyes on the Master and "Go For A Walk With God."
