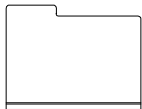

Abram and Lot (13:1-13)

1. Who was Lot?
2. Describe Abram's wealth.
3. What problem developed between Abram and Lot? What character traits did Abram manifest in this incident?
4. What choice did Lot make? Was it a good one? Explain.

Renewed Promises to Abram (11:10-32)

5. What two promises are repeated to Abram? (cf. 12:1-9)

The Slaughter of the Kings (14:1-24)

6. What was the first great consequence Lot suffered because of his move to Sodom? What was the cause of the war described in these verses?
7. How did Abram help Lot? Contrast Abram's attitude toward his kinsmen (v. 8) with that of Cain. (4:9)
8. Who was Melchizedek? What did he do for Abram? What did Abram do in return? (cf. Hebrews 7:1-10)
9. What offer did the king of Sodom make to Abram? Why did Abram refuse it? What can be learned about Abram's faith from this incident?

Abraham Intercedes for Sodom (18:16-33)

10. What reason did God give for revealing to Abraham what He planned to do to Sodom? What was Abraham's reaction to this information?
11. What application, if any, can be made of these verses today?

The Destruction of the Cities of the Plain (19:1-38)

12. What were the two main cities of this group?
13. How was the sinfulness of Sodom illustrated?

14. Why did the messengers of God warn Lot of the impending destruction of the cities?
15. Describe the character of Lot's:
- a. Sons-in-law.
 - b. Wife.
 - c. Daughters.
16. What did Lot's wife do while on their flight from the city? Why? What lesson(s) can be learned from her actions? (cf. Luke 17:32)
17. What lessons, in general, are to be learned from the destruction of Sodom and the other cities of the plain? (cf. 2 Peter 2:4-9)
18. Describe the relationship between the Moabites, Ammonites, and the Israelite descendants of Abraham.
