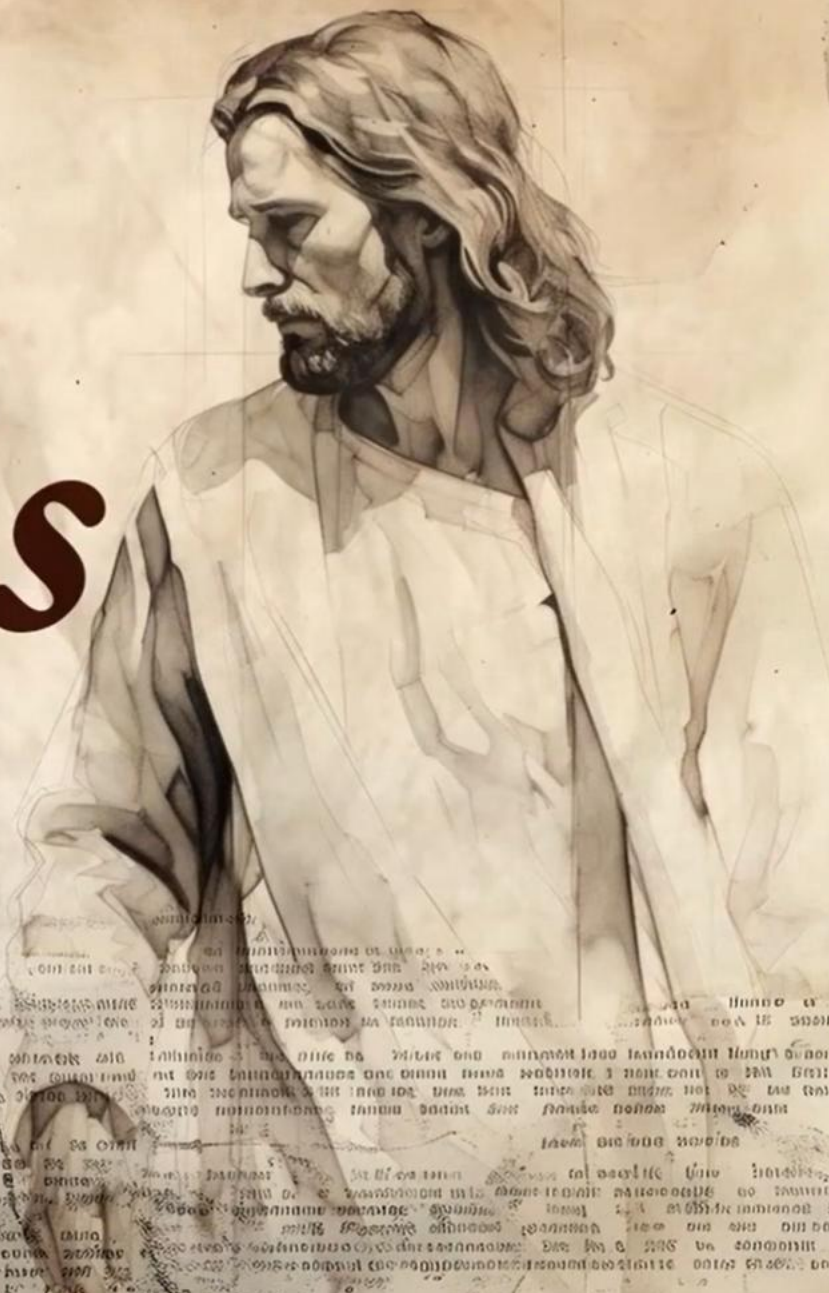


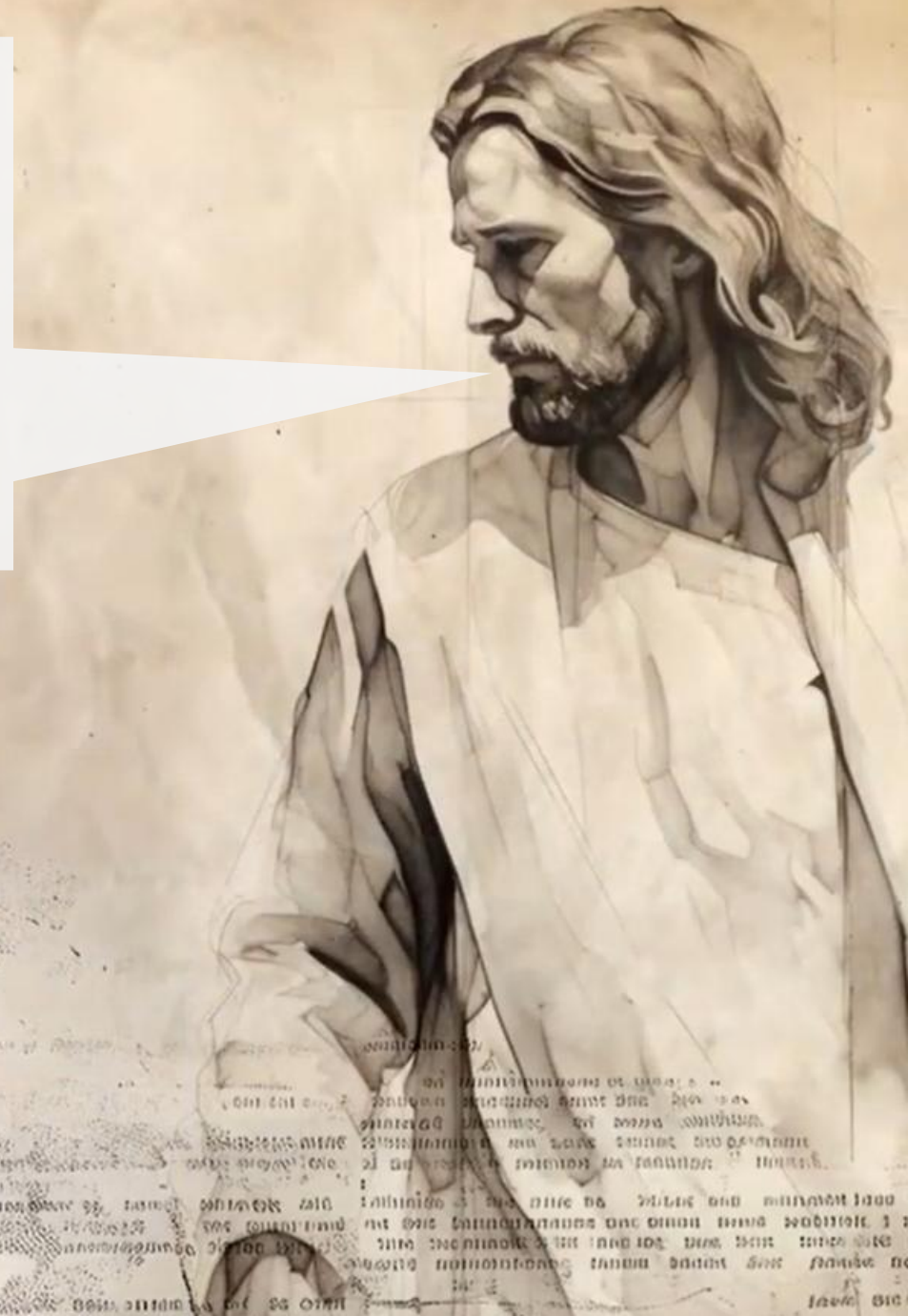
THE *Questions* JESUS ASKED

(Matthew 16:26)***

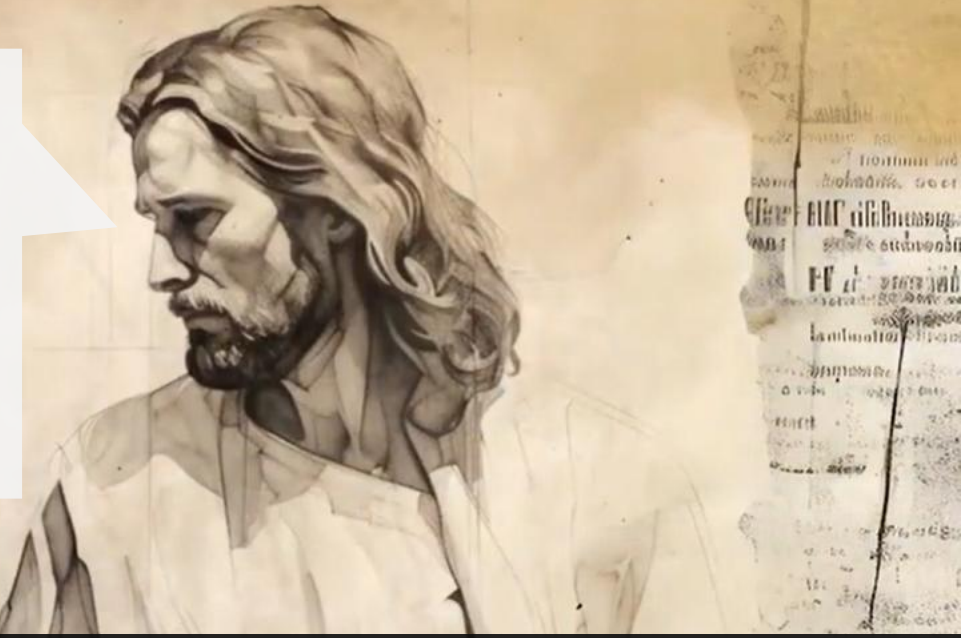


“What do you want Me to do for you” (Matt. 20:32)?



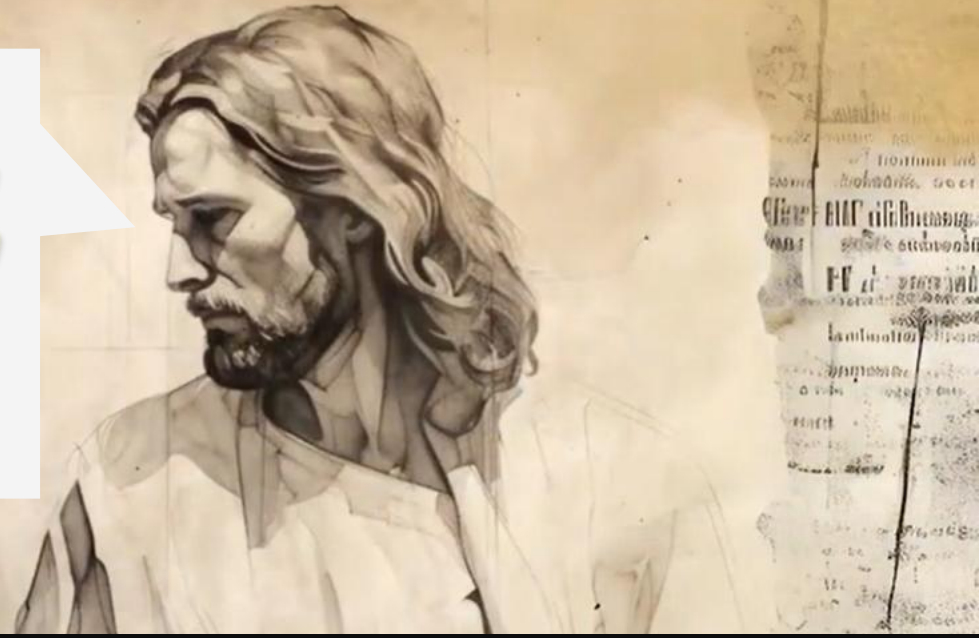
- This question was asked to two blind beggars.
- Their answer: ***“Lord, we want our eyes to be opened” (20:33)***
- The benefit of Jesus’ question was to see their faith expressed.

***“Why do you call me, ‘Lord, Lord,’ and not do what I say”
(Luke 6:46)?***



- This question was asked to people who had come to hear Jesus preach. (v.18)
- They called Jesus **“Lord, Lord”** emphasizing their respect for Him.
- Though they respected Him, they did not obey Him.

***“When the Son of Man comes,
will He find faith on the earth”
(Luke 18:8)?***



- Jesus is not asking if there will be believers on the earth.
- Jesus' question is whether the kind of faith, like the widow, will be present when He returns?
- Jesus' question is about self-examination.

***“Do you love Me”
(John 21:15-17)?***



- Jesus already knew Peter’s answer.
- Jesus’ question was a threefold love parallel to Peter’s threefold denial.
- Jesus’ question ultimately offered reconciliation, forgiveness, and recommissioning.

“Do you love Me?”

***“If you love Me, keep My
commandments” (John 14:15)***
