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"BORN OF WATER" - SOME QUESTIONS

In John 3:5 Jesus declared: "... Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God."

QUESTION: Does "born of water" in John 3:5 mean "the water of a natural or physical birth?"

ANSWER: In an effort to nullify the teaching of Jesus that a man must "be born of water and of the Spirit" in order to enter the kingdom, some preachers will contend that water under consideration here is the water involved in connection with a child being born physically. In other words, it has reference to the fleshly birth! However, a careful reflection on the following facts should show that such an explanation of John 3:5 is false!

- 1. Technically, it is **not** really **water**, but a water-like substance called **amniotic fluid** that is usually associated with giving birth to a child.
- 2. When such "water" (i.e., amniotic fluid) is present it is also "born" the same as the child. Both come forth "of" or "from" the woman!

- 3. Jesus said: "Except a MAN be born of water and of the Spirit..." He did not say, "Except AN UNBORN INFANT be born of water and of the Spirit...!"
- 4. If "water" here means a fleshly birth, does that mean that all "dry birth" children will go go hell?
- 5. Verse 6 says: "That which is born of THE FLESH IS FLESH; ..." Jesus did not way: "That which is born of water IS FLESH!"
- 6. Jesus did not say: "Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot be born PHYSICALLY or be born THE FIRST TIME!
- 7. Jesus was **not** telling Nicodemus how to be born PHYS-ICALLY but how to be born SPIRITUALLY!
- 8. To be born AGAIN one must "be born of water of the Spirit!" A NEW birth, a being born AGAIN is being discussed! To be born AGAIN, to be born FROM ABOVE, one must "be born of water and of the Spirit..."

SOME NEEDED CHANGES

The apostle Paul declared: "Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old thing are passed away; behold, all things are become new." (2 Cor. 5:17). When a penitent believer is baptized INTO Christ (cf. Rom. 6:3-4; Gal. 3:26-27; Acts 2:38), he becomes a new creature, hence, a changed person! Let us now consider some people who need to be changed and the changes they need to make.

- 1. A CARNAL PERSON NEEDS TO BE CHANGED INTO A SPIRITUAL PERSON WHO LOVES GOD! Paul showed the need for this change when he said: "For to be carnally minded is death; but to be spiritually minded is life and peace." (Romans 8:6). This change of mind (i.e., heart) is brought about by faith! (See Heb. 11:6; John 8:21, 24; 20:30-31; Romans 5:1; 2 Cor. 5:7 & Rom. 10:17).
- 2. A PERSON WHO LOVES THE WORLD NEES TO BE CHANGED INTO A PERSON WHO LOVES GOD! John said: "Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him." (1 John 2:15; Also see verses 16-17; Mt. 22:29; 1 John 4:19). This change of affections is brought about by God's love! (See

1 John 4:8-10; 4:19; Rom. 5:8).

3. A PERSON WHO HAS BEEN FOLLOWING MAN'S WAYS NEEDS TO BE CHANGED INTO PERSON WHO FOLLOWS GOD'S WAYS! A careful study of such passages as Jeremiah 10:23: Proverbs 14:12; Isaiah 55:8-9 & Matthew 15:7-9 should establish this point. This change is brought about by repentance! (See 2 Peter 3:9: Acts 17-30; 3:19; Matthew 3:8 & 2 Cor. 7:10). NOTE: Repentance is a change of heart that is wrought by godly sorrow and results in a change of life! PERSON WHO 4. A IS FRIEND OF THE WORLD NEEDS TO BE CHANGED INTO A FRIEND OF CHRIST! James said: "Ye adulterers and adulteresses, know ye not that the friendship of the world is enmity with God? whosoever therefore will be a friend of the world is the enemy of God." (4:4). Jesus declared: "Ye are my friends, if ye do what I command you." (John 15:14: Also see John 14:23-24: 1 John 4:15 & Acts 8:37). This change of allegiance is brought about by confession! (Also see Romans 10:9-

5. A CHILD OF THE DEVIL NEEDS TO BE CHANGED INTO A CHILD OF GOD! In 1 John 3:10 a clear distinction is made between children of God and children of the devil! The "good seed" in Matthew 13:38 are the children of the kingdom and "the tares" are the children of the wicked one! Jesus told some Jews in John 8:44 that they were of their "father the devil." They needed to make a change! They needed to truly become children of God like the Galatians had! See Galatians 3:26-27. This change of relationship takes place baptism! (See Gal. 3:26-27).

6. A CITIZEN OF THE POWER (Continued on page 3)

SOME NEEDED CHANGES

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OF DARKNESS NEEDS TO BE CHANGED INTO A CITIZEN OF THE KINGDOM OF CHRIST! The whole world (without) lies in wickedness and thus is in darkness! Jesus said: "I am come a light into the world, that whosoever believeth on me should not abide in darkness." (John 12:46). Saul was sent to the Gentiles "To open their eves. and to turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan unto God, that they may receive the forgiveness of sins, and inheritance among them which are sanctified by faith" in Christ! (Acts 26:17-18). Saints have been called "out of darkness into His marvelous light." (1 Pet. 2:9). This change of citizenship is brought about by a translation! In Colossians 1:13-14 Paul affirms that the Father ". . . Hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated us into the kingdom of His dear Son." Christians are truly children of light! We ought to act like it! (See Eph. 5:8: Matthew 5:14-16; Phil. 2:15-16 & 1 Thess. 5:4-6).

7. A SINNER NEEDS TO BE CHANGED INTO A CHRISTIAN! At one time Saul was "the chiefest of sinners" but he was changed into a Christian! Paul said: "This is a faithful saying, and worthy of all acceptation, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners; of whom I am chief." (1 Tim. 1:15). We learn from Acts 26:19-32 that Paul endeavored to persuade men to become Christians! (Read and carefully study Acts 11:26; 1 Peter 4:16 and Romans 8:8). This change of name is brought about by the new birth! (See John 3:3-5; 1 Pet. 1:22-25;1 Cor. 4:15; James 1:18). In writing to his brethren James said: "Do not they blaspheme that worthy name by the which ye are called?" (2:7). Instead of being content with wearing the name of Christ, many people choose to wear other names.

- 8. A SERVANT OF SIN NEEDS TO RE CHANGED INTO SERVANT OF RIGHTEOUS-NESS! To the saints at Rome the apostle Paul wrote: "But God be thanked, that we were the servants of sin, but ye have obeyed from the heart that form of doctrine which was delivered you. Being then made free from sin, ye became the servants of righteousness." (Romans 6:17-18). NOTE: Jesus said: "...Whosoever committeth sin is the servant of sin." (John 8:34). In order to become a servant of righteousness, one who is a servant of sin must change his vocation! This change of vocation is brought about by obedience to God! (Carefully study Romans 6:16-23; Eph. 4:1-6; Matthew 7:21: Revelation 22:14: James 1:21-25 and Hebrews 5:9).
- 9. A PERSON WHO IS ON HIS WAY TO HELL NEEDS TO BE CHANGED INTO A PERSON WHO IS ON HIS WAY TO HEAVEN! There are two destinies! Heaven is for the righteous and hell is for the wicked! Read and carfully study Matthew 25:31-46 where a judgment scene is graphically described! The righteous will be told to "Come, ve blessed of my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world" but the wicked will be told to "Depart from me, ve cursed, into everlasting fire, prepared for the devil and his angels." This change of destination is brought about by an obedient faith! (Cf. Hebrews 5:8-9; Gal. 2:20; James 2:24 & Rev. 22:14).

Have you been changed? Are you now a changed person? Do you need to change? If you need to change, NOW IS THE TIME TO AFFECT THAT CHANGE!

"BORN OF WATER" - SOME QUESTIONS

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9. The ONLY water that is involved in the NEW BIRTH is water in which a sinner is baptized in order to be saved! (See Mark 16:15-16; Acts 2:38; 8:36; 10:47-48; 22:16 & 1 Peter 3:21).

QUESTION: When Jesus said "water" in John 3:5 did He mean "LIVING water?"

ANSWER: There is absolutely no evidence that Jesus was discussing "LIVING water" in John 3:5! In John 4:10-15 when Jesus discussed LIVING water He did not say simply water, but He said "LIVING water!" In John 3:5 Jesus said water! He did not say LIVING water! He said what He meant and He meant what He said!

QUESTION: Did Jesus mean "born

of THE SPIRIT" in John 3:5 when He said: "...born of WATER?"

ANSWER: No! He meant "born of WATER!" It is evident that he meant "born...OF THE SPIRIT" when He said: "born...OF THE SPIRIT!" However, when Jesus said "born of WATER" He meant "born of WATER!" Surely, Jesus was NOT saying: "Except a man be born of SPIRIT and of the SPIRIT he cannot enter into the kingdom of God." NOTE: We have no right to change the words of our Saviour just because it does not fit a certain theology!

Let us remember that Paul said: "Prove all things; hold fast that which is good." (1 Thess. 5:21).
