

# Some Responsibilities Of A Christian

- attend church services - Hebrews 10:24-25 **And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works: Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another ....** (this is a command, not just a recommendation)
- pray – I Thess 5:17-18 **Pray without ceasing. In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God ....** (this does not mean at every moment, but regularly without stopping)
- study the Bible regularly – II Tim 2:15 **Be diligent to present yourself approved to God, a worker who does not need to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth. (NKJV) Acts 17:11 These (the Bereans) were more noble than those in Thessalonica, in that they received the word with all readiness of mind, & searched the scriptures daily, whether those things were so.**
- share the gospel with others – Acts 8:1,4 ... there was a great persecution against the church ... and they were all scattered abroad ... except the apostles ... therefore they that were scattered abroad went every where preaching the word.
- clean language (no cussing, no taking the Lord's name in vain, etc.) – Ephesians 4:29 **Let no corrupt communication proceed out of your mouth, but that which is good to the use of edifying, that it may minister grace unto the hearers.**
- be kind and loving toward others – Ephesians 4:32 **And be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you.**
- be a good example to others – Matthew 5:13-16 **Ye are the salt of the earth: but if the salt have lost his savour, wherewith shall it be salted? it is thenceforth good for nothing, but to be cast out, and to be trodden under foot of men. Ye are the light of the world. A city that is set on an hill cannot be hid. Neither do men light a candle, and put it under a bushel, but on a candlestick; and it giveth light unto all that are in the house. Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.**
- don't cause others to sin –Matthew 18:6 **But whoso shall offend one of these little ones which believe in me, it were better for him that ... he were drowned in the depth of the sea.**
- help others – Matthew 20:26-28 **But it shall not be so among you: but whosoever will be great among you, let him be your minister; And whosoever will be chief among you, let him be your servant: Even as the Son of man came not to be ministered unto, but to minister, and to give his life a ransom for many.**
- raise their children to be faithful Christians - Ephesians 6:4 **And, ye fathers, provoke not your children to wrath: but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord.**
- be sexually pure – Galatians 5:19-21 **Now the works of the flesh are manifest, which are these; Adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lasciviousness ... as I have also told you in time past, that they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God.**
