

Old Testament **change** to New Testament

Jeremiah 31:31-32 / Heb 8:8-9 God Would Make A New Covenant

- the old testament predicted this change in the law
- Hebrews quotes Jeremiah to say the predicted change in law has occurred

Hebrews 7:12 The Law Has Changed

- if “change” oil, completely replace old (obsolete) with new; we don’t mix
- this is an “all or nothing” argument

Col 2:14-17 The Old Law Was Blotted Out, Nailed To His Cross

- all four categories blotted out – daily, yearly, monthly, weekly (Sabbath)

Ephesians 2:14-16 The Old Law Is Abolished

- Jesus’ death was to pay for our sins, but also to abolish the old law
- the absence of the old law makes two peoples (Jew and Gentile) into one

Romans 7:4-7 We Are Dead To and Delivered From The Old Law

- even including the 10 commandments

Galatians 3:19 The Old Law Was In Effect Until Christ Came

- but what about now after Jesus has already come?

Galatians 3:24-25 We Are No Longer Under The Old Law

- “under” means subject to, amenable to, responsible to obey

Galatians 5:2-4 We Are Not Justified By The Old Law

- this idea is so critical that we lose our salvation if we seek to bind old law
- not even one part of old law is still binding; “all or nothing” logic again

I Corinthians 16:1-2 First Day Of The Week Collection

- first day of the week, not the seventh day Sabbath

Acts 20:7 First Day Of The Week Lord’s Supper

- wouldn’t this mean every Sunday? (since every week has a first day)
