- Temptation: the desire to do something, especially something wrong or unwise

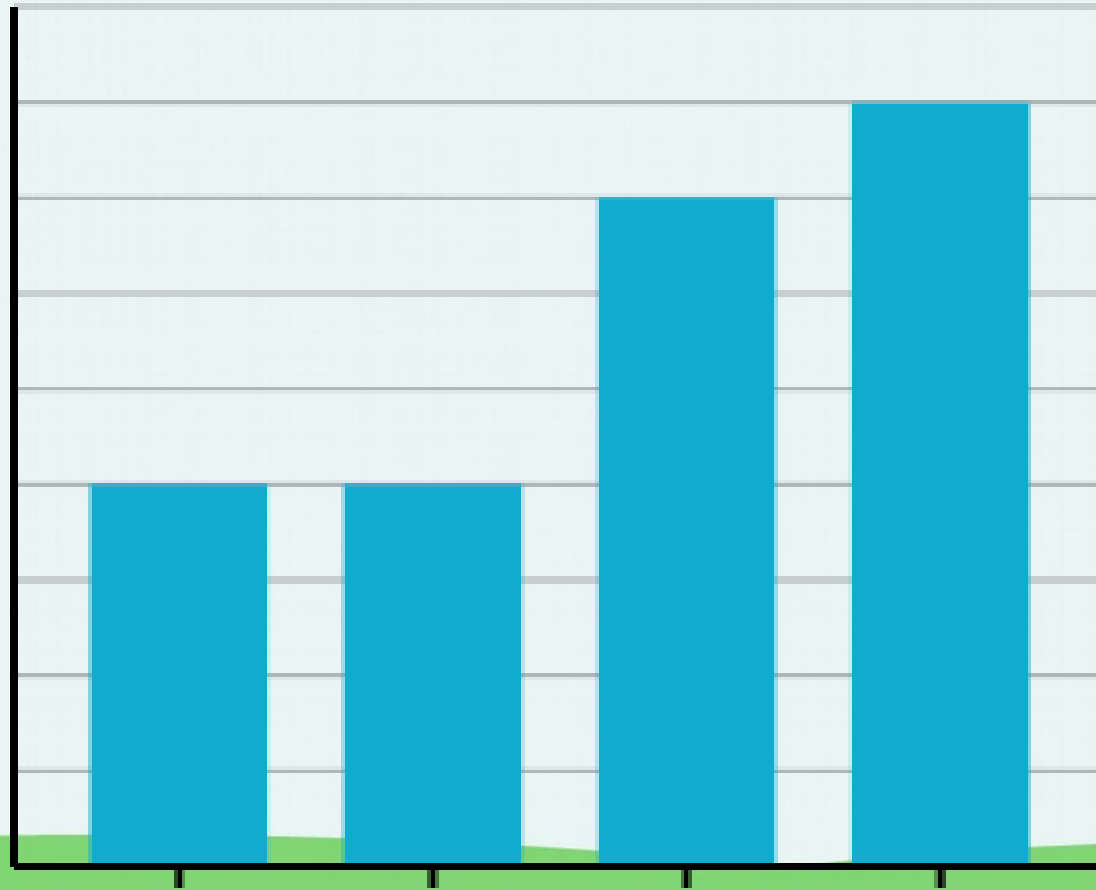


Who Sins?

Overcoming Sin

- Matthew 4:1-11
- Jesus had to lead by example
- The Devil tempted him three times
- People will make it look like it is alright to sin, they will put your faith to the test



Forgiveness

- All have sinned, so all need forgiveness
- Because of Christ, we can be forgiven
- Only God can forgive our sins, but we can ask for forgiveness and we can be baptized for our forgiveness of sins
- Romans 3:24; Colossians 3:13; Acts 2:38
