Sanctification of the people

SECTION 1 : CLEANSING

And the LORD said to Joshua, "Today I have rolled away
the reproach of Egypt from you."

Joshua 5:9 - ESV

SECTION 1 : CLEANSING

- Sign of the covenant between God and His people
 - Gen 17: 10-14

SECTION 1 : CLEANSING

- No circumcision in the wilderness
 - No passover in the wilderness
 - Exodus 12:43-49
-

SECTION 1 : CLEANSING

reproach : an expression of rebuke or disapproval.
a cause or occasion of blame, discredit, or disgrace.

SECTION 1 : CLEANSING

- What was the reproach of Egypt that was on the Israelites?
 - The taunting from Egypt - Exodus 32:11-12
 - Holding on to the customs of Egypt while forsaking the law of God

SECTION 2 : REMEMBERING

- Gilgal - sounds like the Hebrew word for “to roll”
 - Names were established to help them remember the story

SECTION 2 : REMEMBERING

While the people of Israel were encamped at Gilgal, they kept the Passover on the fourteenth day of the month in the evening on the plains of Jericho.

Joshua 5:10 - ESV

SECTION 2 : REMEMBERING

- What was the purpose of the passover?
 - Exodus 12
 - When was the last passover Israel had prior to this?
 - Numbers 9
 - For reference spying of the land happens in Numbers 13

SECTION 2 : PROMISE FULFILLED

And the manna ceased the day after they ate of the produce of the land. And there was no longer manna for the people of Israel, but they ate of the fruit of the land of Canaan that year.

Joshua 5:12 - ESV

SECTION 2 : PROMISE FULFILLED

- Part of the reproach of Egypt
 - Exodus 16:3
 - God's provision for them
 - Provisions were no longer needed in the promise land

SECTION 3 : GOD'S ARMY
