

# SCYC: Guidelines & Requirements

- The guidelines and requirements apply to all campers, staff, and visitors during camp week, and they are provided for the safety and well-being of each individual in attendance at SCYC.
- Campers are subject to direction and correction by any staff member. The camp director may send home any camper who is guilty of persistent disobedience or violation of camp rules. If a egregious violation of these rules results in the camper being sent home - no refund will be given.
- No one (campers, staff, visitors) is to leave camp for any reason without the permission of the camp director. For insurance purposes, **ALL staff, campers, visitors must sign-in and out with the camp director during the week. The sheet will be located in the lodge.**
- Full supplemental accident insurance is carried on all campers and staff. Campers who are in need of medical attention or dispensing of medications are asked to see the nurse or camp director.
- Christian behavior is expected at all times.
- All campers and staff are expected to participate and/or attend all the camp activities.
- Improper/bad language, malicious pranks and/or hazing, vandalism, alcohol/drugs/tobacco/vaping products, weapons (including air-soft), fireworks, lighters, or matches are forbidden and will not be tolerated. Any damages will be charged to the responsible parties and/or parents.
- Snacks will be provided. Please limit what you bring to camp for your cabins.
- **Dress Code:** Modest dress is expected at all times! Clothing **NOT ALLOWED** will include: any clothing that is tight fitting, to small, low cut (mid-drift must not show), spaghetti straps, revealing cutoff shirts (Note: Sleeveless shirts may be worn, but must be 2 inches wide across the shoulders.), tank tops, clothing promoting alcohol, drugs, or profanity, etc. Skirts and shorts must extend to mid-thigh or longer when properly fitted at the waist. Undergarments must not be showing outside of your clothes. Swimwear should be appropriate length trunks for boys, and girls must wear one-piece swimsuits or dark-colored t-shirts that will cover two-piece swimsuits. Anyone (campers, staff, and/or visitors) dressing inappropriately/immodestly will be asked to change immediately.
- Shoes and socks will be required for all physical activities. Sandals, Crocs, etc. will not be allowed to be worn during these activities. Campers are also expected to wear either shoes or sandals during the entire week of camp. No camper will be allowed to go barefoot at anytime.
- Electronics are only allowed in cabins during free time. Small electronic items may be brought to camp, but it is highly recommended that you leave them at home. SCYC is not responsible for lost or stolen items. Also, electronics may be confiscated at anytime by the camp staff if not being used as suggested. **(Note: Phones may be used for picture taking only outside of the cabins.)**
- No girls are allowed in or around the boys' cabins and vice versa. No exceptions!
- Cabins are to be cleaned daily and will be inspected. If a cabin is not at or above a passing mark based upon inspection, the cabin residents and counselors will be instructed to clean up before other activities take place. Cabin cleanliness guidelines will be posted in each cabin during the week.
- No overnight visitors without permission from the camp director. (Based on space availability.)

## Things to Bring to SCYC to help make your week go smooth!

- Bible, paper, pencils/pens, stamps, and a personal journey
- Sheets, blankets, sleeping bag, and pillow (bunk beds are twin size mattresses)
- Towels, washcloths, & toiletry items (soap, shampoo, toothpaste, etc.)
- Medications that must be taken. (A nurse will be on staff to assist with dispensing.)
- **MODEST** and the appropriate amount of clothing for all camp activities. (No clothing washing!!)
- Sports equipment if you wish
- Flashlight, Insect Repellent, Basic Survival Kit (ha/ha)
- Light jacket, poncho, or umbrella
- **AN ATTITUDE TO HAVE FUN AND LEARN MORE ABOUT THE WORD OF GOD!**

Our week of camp will be Sunday, June 20<sup>th</sup> to Friday, June 25<sup>th</sup>. We are looking forward to having you with us as we look to share with you about God and how to better deal with the everyday trials of life. That's just a little hint! The camp theme will once again be a secret until you arrive for your week with all the staff and other campers. While we are ultimately at camp to study God's word, we also have a week of fun-filled events planned to make your week at camp a most memorable one.

- **What is church camp?** Camp is an opportunity for kids and adults to engage in a period of Bible study and fellowship while enjoying God's beautiful creation. It is conducted by a staff that has many years of experience in Christian camping. A well rounded program of activities provides the camper with times of fun and spiritual growth.
- **What do you do at church camp?** There are many activities like team games (basketball, softball, soccer, etc.), water activities, skits, and other group activities that help a camper to learn to interact with his peers. There are also individual activities like crafts, board games, and just hanging out, to give the camper an opportunity to enjoy themselves. Bible classes, devotionals, singing silly songs, Jr./Sr. Camper nightly devotionals, and other interactions with faithful Christians are held daily to help each camper to grow closer together and closer to God.
- **Where is SCYC held?** Taylor Christian Camp is located on a large, beautiful ridge in Holland, Kentucky, which is nine miles east of Scottsville, Kentucky on Highway 100. The camp has cabins for every age group, both male and female, bathhouses, pavilions, a dining hall, ball fields, hiking trails...in a word, everything a camp needs to provide a good experience for the camper. - **Who can go to church camp?** Any child who has finished the 3<sup>rd</sup> grade of the current school year can attend camp. Eligibility continues through the summer they graduate from high school. Pre-campers may attend, however, they must attend with an adult/staff member.
- **When is SCYC?** The third week of June - Sunday, June 20<sup>th</sup> thru Friday, June 25<sup>th</sup>
- **How do I sign up?** 1) Fill out the inserted camper application. 2) Get it notarized! & 3) Mail or give the application and camp fee to one of the camp director or your local church representative.
