I greet everyone and with thanks I am asking for help in the ministry, refugees and poor people who will visit our church. The services we conduct:

1. Sunday - our hall is constantly full, there are not enough chairs and places for all Christians and guests, the total number of seats is 40, but every Sunday this number exceeds that we are forced to ask people to come at another hour.
2. Tuesday - we have a fraternal meeting, in which we pray for the Church in Poltava and other churches and ministries that we lead and plan to lead.
3. Wednesday - we study with a certified teacher how to sing better, train our voices.
4. Thursday - meeting for Bible study.
5. Friday - gathering for book study of the Acts of the Holy Apostles.
6. Saturday - gathering for young people. Our evangelization is now going through parents who have small children, refugees of various ages and the help of pensioners, during the war in the country there is a problem with funding, they receive 50 dollars a month, we help them with food. We bought baby food, diapers, hygiene products, and we also bought food for other people. With your help, we help our Christians who have moved and lost their homes since the war. We don't have baptisms yet, but there are three people who are thinking about it.
