The following is a report from Artur. I will soon send a report about my trip to Warsaw, Poland and Camp Amerikraine there. For now, please read about Artur's great work he is doing.

I will start right away with the important thing, which is to thank God and you for your generosity.

During three weeks, I was in four cities, where I personally saw how exactly you help, and that the money is spent correctly, it is the purchase of food: vegetables, flour, oil, various cereals, spaghetti, pasta.

Personal hygiene products are also purchased.

Lviv (western Ukraine): there are no problems with food, and with other things at the moment, but there was and is a need to rent housing for refugees, thank you very much for that!

Poltava (central-eastern Ukraine): I was there for two weeks and preached in the Church for two Sundays, took part in the life of the church and with the help of yours, we bought 1 ton of potatoes, 300 kilograms of beets, 100 kilograms of onions, 300 kilograms of cabbage .

They also bought oils, flour, and cereals.

We bought soap, toothpaste, shampoos, washing powder, toothbrushes.

We organized 100 packages for the refugees in the photo.

Kharkiv (eastern Ukraine) - I had to personally take part in the delivery of humanitarian aid, and help unload all the things we brought, Kharkiv borders Russia, and the city is shelled, sometimes the city is shelled and sometimes it is quiet. I can assure everyone who supports Ukraine financially, the money that was used went to a good cause.

Kremenchuk (central Ukraine) - the work of our sister in Christ Inna is still supported with your help, she helps refugees and victims of the shopping center that was bombed by Russia. I was near the destroyed shopping center and everything looks very sad.

Several Christians went with me to Lviv to visit and rest at the Amerikraine camp. A camp for Christians, which will help many to distract themselves from the war and fill themselves spiritually.
