The majority of our focus will be in *John 12-21* to: 1) Take an in-depth look at the final words of Jesus to the apostles before He is arrested and crucified; 2) Have plenty of time to discuss and flesh out the ideas and practices of "feet washing" and the "new commandment" Jesus gives in *John 13*; 3) Focus on Jesus' death, burial, and resurrection. Before launching right into the second half of the book, we'll have a few classes to talk about big things that happened in the first half of John. These will be mostly periods of conversations about big ideas from each chapter/story that takes place, rather than the more "paragraph-by-paragraph" lessons we'll be doing in the back half of John.
