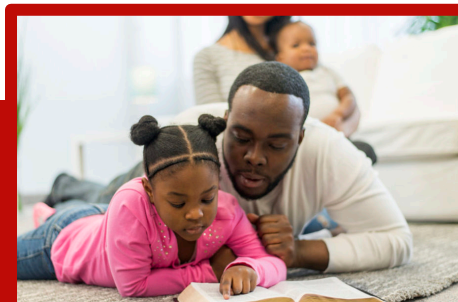
Reading Objective
