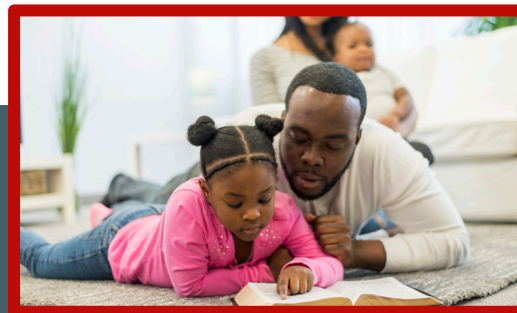
Reading Objective
