

Should I Come to the Assembly?

We look forward to the day when we can have our full assemblies without endangering anyone in the group, but until the risk of infection has declined we must continue to exercise caution to prevent unnecessary severe sickness and loss of life.

In the interest of preserving the lives and well-being of our brothers and sisters, please do not come if you have ANY symptoms of ANY infection, even if they are just cold symptoms or mild abdominal upset!

The following people are asked to stay at home. Those who have:

- Any symptom of an infection
- Recently traveled to high-risk areas
- Recently traveled using public transit
 - Plane
 - Bus
 - Carpool
 - Ride service such as Uber, Lyft
 - Taxi
- Spent time in *close contact* with others outside their family (the more people, the closer the contact, and the longer the time spent, the greater will be the risk of infection)

You should seriously *consider* staying at home if you are at high risk of severe sickness or death from the virus. A list of conditions that increase susceptibility is provided on the accompanying page entitled **“Who Are the Members at Highest Risk?”**
