## THIS WEEK'S SCRIPTURE: PSALM 113

- 1 Praise the Lord. Praise the Lord, you his servants; praise the name of the Lord.
- 2 Let the name of the Lord be praised, both now and forevermore.
- 3 From the rising of the sun to the place where it sets, the name of the Lord is to be praised.
- 4 The Lord is exalted over all the nations, his glory above the heavens.
- 5 Who is like the Lord our God, the One who sits enthroned on high,
- 6 who stoops down to look on the heavens and the earth?
- 7 He raises the poor from the dust and lifts the needy from the ash heap;
- 8 he seats them with princes, with the princes of his people.
- 9 He settles the childless woman in her home as a happy mother of children.

## DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

- According to verses 1-3, when and where should the Lord's servants want to see the Lord praised? What are you doing to see this desire fulfilled? How will the Lord be praised where you are today?
- Verses 4-6 tell of the stature of God. His glory is exalted higher than the heavens, yet he stoops down to look at the earth. Can you think of any Bible stories or passages that show examples of God doing this? How has God stooped to meet you where you are?
- Verses 7-9 celebrate God's care for the outcast, the marginal, and the forgotten. How many examples of the poor being lifted up, or the childless given children can you think of in scripture? Do you know someone who is down or forgotten? How will God use you to lift them up today?
