The resurrection.
26. John 2:18-22
Jesus cleansed the temple and predicts His death.
27. John 4:21-24
Worship in spirit and truth (worshipping God in the prescribed manner)
28. John 8:28-30
Jesus speaks of His death (when you lift up the Son of Man)
29. John 12:27-33
Jesus predicts His death on the cross.
30. John 15:13.
No greater love than to give one's life for friends. (Jesus's sacrifice displayed His love for us).
31. John 19:1-3
Jesus is mocked by the soldiers.
32. John 19:17-24
Jesus on the cross.
33. John 19:28-30
Jesus dies on the cross.
34. John 20:1-10
The empty tomb.
35. Acts 20:7-12
Disciples gathering on the first day of the week to take the Lord's supper and learn from scripture.
36. Romans 5:6-11
Christ died for us while we were still sinners.
37. Romans 5:18,19
Through one man's sin... by one man's obedience...
38. Romans 8:3-8
God sent His Son to fulfill the law, flesh vs. Spirit. Have the right mindset.
39. 1 Corinthians 5:6-8
Keep the feast with the unleavened bread and of sincerity.
40. 1 Corinthians 11:17-22
Admonition regarding misuse of the Lord's supper.
41. 1 Corinthians 11:23-26
The institution of the Lord's supper.
42. 1 Corinthians 11:27-43
Self-examination during the Lord's supper.
43. 1 Corinthians 15:3-5
The risen Lord is preached.
44. 1 Corinthians 15:12-19
The risen Lord, the reason for our hope. (Reason for proclaiming His resurrection)
45. 2 Corinthians 5:1-8
Our hope in the resurrection of being present with the Lord. (Reason for proclaiming His resurrection)
46. Galatians 1:4
He gave Himself for us
47. Galatians 3:13-14
Christ redeemed us.
48. Galatians 4:4-6
Redemption of those under the law and adoption of those under bondage of sin.
49. Ephesians 1:7-9
Redemption through His blood made known by God's will.

50. Ephesians 2:4-5
He showed His love for us even when we were dead in sin.
51. Ephesians 2:11-13
We are brought near to God by the blood of Christ.
52. Ephesians 3:17-19
To understand the bounds of God's love for us through the sacrifice of His son.
53. Philippians 2:5-11
Jesus humbled Himself and was obedient even to the point of death on the cross.
54. Philippians 4:8,9
Meditate on these things.
55. Colossians 1:19-22
Reconciled in Christ.
56. Colossians 2:13-15
Removed the handwriting of requirements that was against us nailing it to the cross.
57. Colossians 3:1-4
Set your mind on things above hope in the resurrection.
58. 1 Thessalonians 1:9-10
Being a good example and looking forward to Christ's return and the salvation from God's wrath.
59. 1 Thessalonians 4:13-18
Comfort in the return of Christ. That which we proclaim until His return.
60. 1 Timothy 2:1-7
One mediator who gave Himself as a ransom for all.
61. Titus 2:11-15
Looking forward to Christ's return to redeem His special people.
62. Hebrews 2:9
Received glory and honor through His death that brought salvation to all.
63. Hebrews 2:14-18
What Jesus's death and resurrection accomplished.
64. Hebrews 7:18-19.
The better covenant (cf. Matt. 26:28).
65. Hebrews 7:22-28
Surety of a better covenant, offered up Himself.
66. Hebrews 8:10 -13
The new covenant.
67. Hebrews 9:11-15
Christ, the mediator of the new covenant through His sacrifice and blood.
68. Hebrews 9:26-28
Christ's sacrifice.
69. Hebrews 10:10
We are sanctified by Christ's obedient self-sacrifice.
70. Hebrews 10:11-18
Christ's sacrifice completes our sanctification.
71. 1 Peter 1:3-12
Heavenly inheritance, so great a gift that was given by Christ's death and resurrection.
72. 2 Peter 3:10-13
Looking forward to Christ's return.
73. 1 John 1:6,7
Fellowship with Christ and one another. Cleansing by the blood.
74. 1 John 4:10
God's love displayed through the sacrifice of His son.
75. Revelation 1:6,7
First of the resurrected, washed us in His blood. Looking forward to His return.

76. Revelation 21:22-27
The hope of eternity.
77. Genesis 22:1-8
The shadowy sacrificial offering of the Son of promise.
78. Exodus 3:14-15
The living God of those who are alive in Him just as Jesus is the living Lord of those who are alive in Him (cf. Jn. 8:58).
79. Exodus 6:6-8
Redemption through the covenant.
80. Exodus 12:5
The shadow of a one year old male lamb, without blemish.
81. Exodus 12:12-28
The ordinances of the Passover. The memorial feast of being freed from bondage.
82. Psalms 1:1-3
Delight in the law of the Lord. (The attitude we should have while fulfilling a command)
83. Psalms 16:8-17
The prophecy of the Messiah's death and resurrection.
84. Psalms 18:43-50
The prophecy of the victory of Christ.
85. Psalms 22
The prophecy of the sufferings and Lordship of the Messiah.
86. Psalms 40:9,10
Proclaim the good word. Proclaim His righteousness and salvation through His sacrifice.
87. Psalms 69:20-21
The prophesy of Christ's suffering.
88. Psalms 145:4-9
Teach our children about the sacrifice of Christ and why we hold it in memory.
89. Isaiah 53:1-12
The prophecy of the suffering Messiah.
90. Jonah 1:10-2:10
Jonah's sacrifice to save the sailors, 3 days and nights in the belly of the fish.
