

He exists

- Genesis begins with foundation of God's existence (Genesis 1:1)
- The creation testifies that God exists (Romans 1:20)
- It declares the glory that he has (Psalm 19:1)

He is worthy of worship

- We are God's creatures (Genesis 1:26-27)
 - We do not belong to ourselves (Psalm 100:3)
 - Being his creatures, he is worthy of our honor (note Romans 1:20-21)
- He is worthy of worship for his act of creation (Nehemiah 9:6; Psalm 148:1-6)
 - None other are like God (Psalm 86:8-10)
 - His name alone is exalted (Psalm 148:13)

He is all powerful

- In the beginning, God spoke matter into existence (Genesis 1:1; Hebrews 11:3)
- God creation was done with great power (Jeremiah 32:17)
- Creation proves the eternal power that he has (Romans 1:20)

He is the lawgiver

- God gave man law in the garden (Genesis 2:16-17)
 - There are things to be done (or not done) to be pleasing to God
 - The consequence of disobedience is death (cf. Romans 6:23)
- As Creator, he has this right
 - All things belong to God (Psalm 24:1-2)
 - The Creator is to be served (note Romans 1:25)

He is the faithful creator

“Therefore let those who suffer according to God's will entrust their souls to a faithful Creator while doing good.” (1 Peter 4:19)
