Draw Near – Hold Fast – Consider


- “... let us **draw near** with a true heart in full assurance of faith, with our hearts sprinkled clean from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water.” (10:22)
 - This is an admonition to obey the gospel of Christ!
 - **Galatians 3:26-27; 1 Peter 3:21; Acts 22:16**

Draw Near – Hold Fast – Consider

- *“Let us **hold fast** the confession of our hope without wavering, for he who promised is faithful.” (10:23)*
 - The Hebrew writer encourages us to hold onto our faith – to remember the confession we made at the beginning!
 - **Romans 10:9**

Draw Near – Hold Fast – Consider

- “And let us **consider** how to stir up one another to love and good works ...” (10:24)
 - Consider the life and eternal destiny of our brethren.
 - The child of God, washed clean through faithful obedience, has no selfishness in his character.^[SEP]
 - **Romans 12:16; Philippians 2:3-5; Hebrews 10:25**
