


Obadiah's Message to Edom & Judah

- The vision of Obadiah. Thus says the Lord God concerning Edom:
 We have heard a report from the Lord, and a messenger has
 been sent among the nations: Rise up! Let us rise against her for
 battle! (1:1)
- The background for Israel's struggle with Edom has deep roots in the Bible:
 - It begins with the tension between Jacob and Esau. (Genesis 25:23; 27:1-41)
 - Saul, David and Solomon all have battles with the Edomites.
 (1 Samuel 14:47; 2 Samuel 8:14; 1 Kings 11:14)
 - When Jerusalem fell to Babylon, Edom rejoiced and took advantage of Judah. (Psalm 137:7; Lamentations 4:21; Ezekiel 35)

Obadiah's Message to Edom & Judah

- The book breaks down into two major sections:
 - Accusations against Edom and God's impending judgment against them (1:1-14)
 - Because of their pride (1:3-4)
 - Because they trusted in their own wisdom (1:8; Jer. 49:7)
 - Violence against God's people (1:10)





Obadiah's Message to Edom & Judah

- The book breaks down into two major sections:
 - Accusations against Edom and God's impending judgment against them. (1:1-14)
 - Because of their pride (1:3-4)
 - Because they boasted in their own wisdom (1:8; Jer. 49:7)
 - Violence against God's people (1:10)
 - God's judgment against all nations. (1:15-21)
- The book closes with an important contrast:
 - Edom will be totally destroyed, and will never exist as a nation again.
 - The Jews will be restored. (1:17-21)

Obadiah's Message to Us Today

- 1) God is watching, and cares what happens to His people He knows when His people suffer!
- 2) Edom's rise and fall is an illustration of what happens to both nations and people who revolt against God and oppress His people!
- 3) God sees and is coming in judgment and will take vengeance on the wicked – the ultimate "victory" of God's people over those who oppress them!
