Prophet and Priest and King

1 Long ago, at many times and in many ways, God spoke to our fathers by the prophets, 2 but in these last days he has **spoken to us by his Son** whom he appointed the heir of all things, through whom also he created the world. 3 He is the radiance of the glory of God and the exact imprint of his nature, and he upholds the universe by the word of his power. After **making purification for sins** he **sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high**

A Prophet Shall God Raise Up

Deuteronomy 18:15-19

- 1st century Jews were expecting “the” prophet (John 1:19-21, 25; 6:14; 7:40)
- Peter applied Moses’ prophecy (Deut. 18) to Jesus (Acts 3:18-26)

“This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased; listen to him” (Matt 17:5)

- Holy Spirit sent “in My name” will guide into “all truth” (John 14:26; 16:13)

Jesus delegated His authority to speak for God to His apostles

- What they would “bind” and “loose” was “bound” and “loosed in heaven” (Mt. 16:19)
- Jesus intended that we would believe in Him through their word (John 17:20)

“If you abide in my word, you are truly my disciples” (John 8:31)

“it is to Him you shall listen”

Thou Shalt be a **Priest** Forever

Psalm 110:1-4

- *“Christ did not exalt himself to be made a high priest, but was appointed by him who said to him, ‘You are my Son, today I have begotten you’ (Heb 5:5)*
- He was *“designated by God a high priest after the order of Melchizedek” (Heb. 5:10)*

Christ is just the priest we needed (Heb. 7:25-26)

Through His own blood, He secured eternal redemption (Heb. 9:12)

- *“He has appeared once for all at the end of the ages to put away sin by the sacrifice of himself” (Heb. 9:26)*

Our high priest gives us confident assurance (Heb. 10:19-23)

“let us draw near with a true heart”

King of kings and Lord of lords

John 18:33-37

*“put all things under his feet and gave him as head over all things to the church”
(Eph 1:22)*

He is Ruler of the kings of earth, but He is not like the kings of earth...

- *“Ruler of kings on earth...who loves us and has freed us from our sins by his blood and made us a kingdom” (Rev. 1:5-6)*
- *“He is Lord of lords and King of kings, and those with him are called and chosen and faithful” (Rev. 17:14)*

“He has... transferred us to the kingdom of his beloved Son” (Col. 1:13)

“My kingdom is not of this world”

King of kings and Lord of lords

“But our citizenship is in heaven, and from it we await a Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ...”
