**INTRODUCTION**

- B. But, what is the purpose of the Lord's Supper?
  - 1. The easy answer, "a memorial of Jesus' death, burial and resurrection."
  - 2. But if we pause for a moment and look deeper...

**I. THE FIVE-WAY LOOK.**

- A. We Look Back to the Cross.
  - 1. We remember what Jesus did for us.
  - 2. John 3:16
  - 3. Romans 5:6-8
- B. We Look Up to Jesus.
  - 1. We confirm that He rose from the dead.
  - 2. And that He ascended to the Father in heaven.
  - 3. Based on eyewitness accounts: Matt. 28:6-7; Acts 1:11.
- C. We Look Forward to Christ's Second Coming.
  - 1. Paul reminds us of His coming, 1 Cor. 11:26.
  - 2. It is a pledge of His return, John 14:1-3.
  - 3. It is also a foretaste of "*the great marriage feast*," Rev. 19:7, 9.
- D. Look Outward to Fellow Christians.
  - 1. During the Lord's Supper, we commune with Christ.
  - 2. We also commune with other Christians, 1 Cor. 11:17-19, 33-34.
  - 3. 1 Cor. 10:16 – we partake of the cup of blessing and the bread.
  - 4. One bread – one body, 1 Cor. 10:17.
- E. We Look Inward – self-examination.
  - 1. 1 Cor. 11:28
  - 2. 2 Cor. 13:5
