Bible Drill Questions

Dear N. Beach Members,

Over the past few years, we have encouraged family bible study for our students outside of class time. We believe that preparation for the Bible drill gives parents the opportunity to work with their children; something that's beneficial to both students and parents.

Attached is a list of edited/revised questions grouped in levels 1 to 5 corresponding to level of difficulty. The easiest questions are level 1 and the more difficult are level 5. To give some guidelines as to where students might fall in these categories, we provide a range of ages and levels.

Bible drill will be scheduled one time a month for each age group/class. Each Bible drill session should have two age groups/classes of students. Here is schedule.

- 1st Sunday Night of the month – Grades 6 - 9 & Grades 10 - 12
- 2nd Sunday Night of the month – Ages 4 years old and Grades K & 1
- 3rd Sunday Night of the month, - Grades 2 & 3 and 4 & 5

Students should be prepared to answer any question for their level, as well as any question from a lower level. For example, a 5th grader should be able to answer any question in levels 1 through 3. A 1st grader should be able to answer any question in levels 1 and 2.

Where there is an overlap, for instance, a 9th grader should be able to answer any question in levels 1 through 4, and able to learn any questions in level 5.

Questions and comments are welcome as we continue to develop this experience.
